WARNING

- Maximum weight load limit up to 150kg (23st).

 LDPE	Low Density Polyethylene (PE bag)	Shopping bags, bread bags, squeeze bottles, stretch/pallet wrap, bubble wrap, multi-pack can holders	Usually recyclable supermarket deposit points. Check other plastic films as any non-polythene film e.g. cling film, crisp packets film lids
 PP	Polypropylene (product)	Microwaveable food containers, yoghurt pots, butter tubs, disposable plates and cups	Commonly recycled and collected from household recycling bins (packaging tape itself not recyclable but does not interfere with cardboard)
