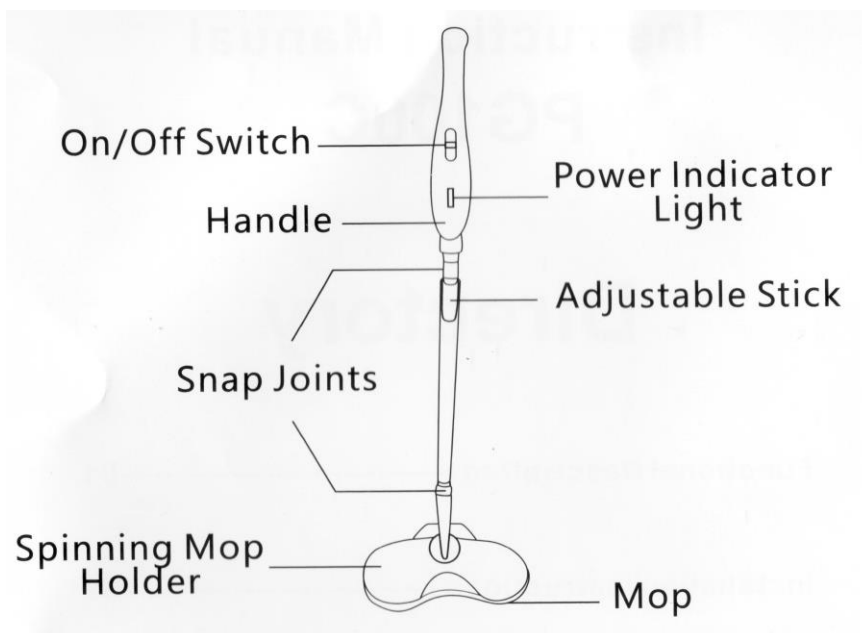

Parts



Assembly

- ① Take out the handle.



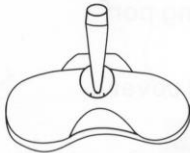
- ② Take out the adjustable stick.



- ③ Attach handle to the adjustable stick, turn the snap joint to connect.



- ④ Take out the spinning mop holder.

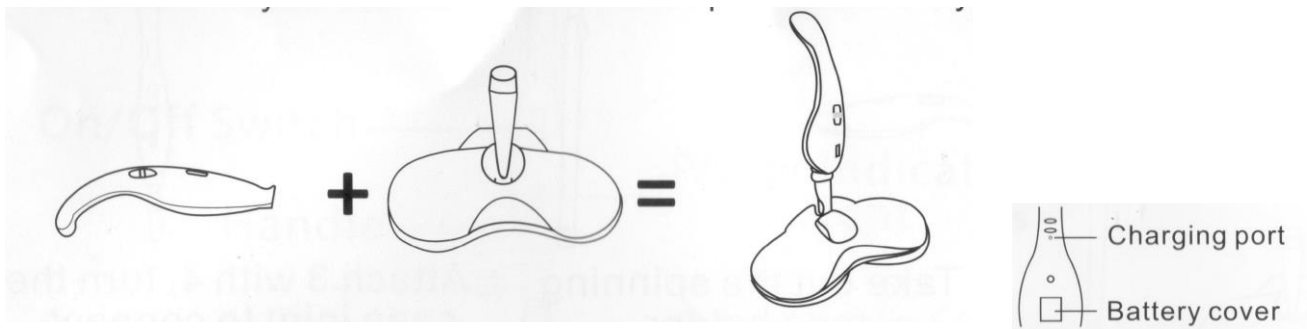


- ⑤ Attach spinning mop holder with assembled parts, turn the snap joint to connect.



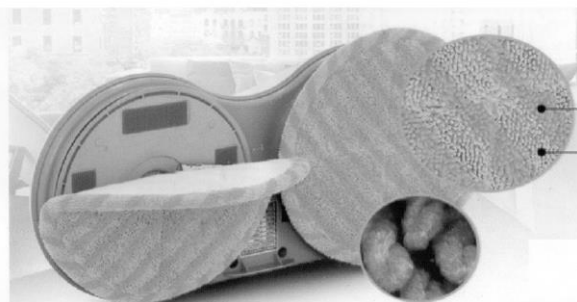
Multi-function handle instructions

The handle can be connected with the adjustable stick or the mop holder directly.



The handle can be removed from the unit for charging but the switch must be turned off.

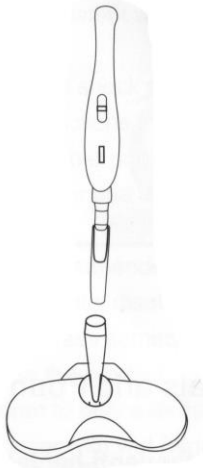
Mop pad installation instructions



Attach hook and loop stickers to the underside of the mop holder and fit mop pad. Ensure pad sits on the holder smoothly and evenly.

Disassemble the Eazy Glide Mop

Unplug the power cord to disassemble the mop

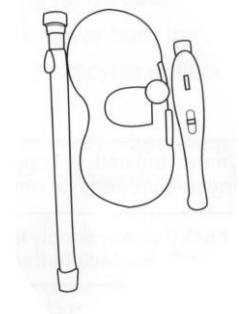


Spin out the lower snap joint to separate the adjustable stick from the mop cloth holder.

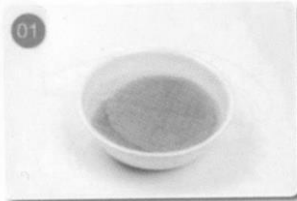


Spin out the snap joint to separate the adjustable stick from the handle.

Store away



Mop Pad Washing and Drying Instructions



- Immerse the mop pad in some water with detergent.
- Let the pad soak for 3-5 minutes.
- Gently wring dry.

Troubleshooting
