
Hold up the seat handle to fold the rollator as shown in figure 4

- 2. Keep holding the brake handle to remain stationary or release brake to move rollator.






Figure 6 (locked)

UNLOCKING HAND BRAKES

- 1. Pull up the brake handles to release as shown in FIGURE 5.
- 2. Release brake handle.
- 3. Ensure the brake cable is fixed along the side tube and any excess cable should be rolled up in front of the rollator.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- 1. Ensure that ALL attaching hardware is secure at ALL times
- 2. Check screw to secure seat to side slot for tightness. If not, tighten if necessary.
- 3. Replace any broken, damaged or worn items immediately.

CARE OF WHEELED ACCESSORIES

- 1. Clean wheels with warm water and mild cleaner. Dry with a clean rag.
- 2. Lubricate with 3-in-l oil periodically or if wheels begin to squeak.

DISPOSAL

- Dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons, plastic and plastic bags in accordance with your local recycling regulations.
