



- Do not use this lint remover on delicate easily damaged fabrics. If unsure test the fabric's suitability on an unexposed area first

#### PREPARATIONS FOR USE

- To use with A/C adapter, plug one end into the DC socket on your lint remover, and the other end into a mains socket.
- To use with batteries, pull out the removable lint collector to expose the battery compartment. Open the cover of the compartment via the clip on the left hand side. Install 4 C batteries, as indicated, close the compartment and clip the lint collector back into place.
- Switch lint remover ON.
- Place fabric on a flat surface such as an ironing board and pull it as straight as possible.
- Tuck in any loose threads before shaving and test the fabric's suitability on an unexposed area first.
- Gently glide the shaving head over the fabric in an up and down motion.
- Do not press down heavily in order to prevent possible damage to fabric.
- Empty the lint collector after each use.

- UNPLUG FROM OUTLET WHEN NOT IN USE AND BEFORE CLEANING.

  APPLIANCE MALFUNCTIONS, OR HAS BEEN DAMAGED IN ANY MANNER. WE RECOMMEND THAT
  THE POWER CABLE IS NOT KINKED OR STORED IN A TWISTED MANNER, AND THAT YOU REGULARLY

# **PLUG WIRING (UK & IRELAND)**

This appliance is supplied with a mains adaptor/charger with BS1363 plug pins.

**DO NOT** use if the socket outlets in your home or office are not suitable for this product's mains adaptor/charger plug pins. Attempts to insert the mains adaptor/charger into the wrong socket is likely to cause electric hazard or damage.

**DO NOT** use with any other mains transformer/charger than the one that is supplied with this product.

## **CARE AND CLEANING**

- Use a damp cloth to wipe the surface of your lint remover. Do not allow water or other liquid to enter the inner parts of this device.
- To clean the shaving head or blades, switch off and unplug your lint remover. Unscrew the shaving head and use the cleaning brush provided to remove any bobbles or lint pieces then screw the shaving head back on. Blades are sharp so please use caution.
- If the screen cover is loose or open when the power is on the motor will shut down.
- Remove the batteries if your lint remover will not be used for a long period of time.

#### **BATTERIES**

- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Install batteries in accordance with its polarity symbols.
- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
- Battery disposal, spent or expired batteries must be properly disposed of and recycled in compliance with local regulations. For detailed information, contact your local authority.
- Follow the battery manufacturer's safety, usage, and disposal instructions.

#### **DISPOSAL**

- Dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons and plastic, plastic bags in accordance with your local recycling regulations.
