Instructions

The Light Up Butterfly Globe comes with an On/Off/Timer switch. Before setting the protective rubber cover needs to be removed and the battery housing opened. Install batteries as shown (A). Make sure the On/Off/Timer switch at the base is in the off position.

Push switch to ON position for the lights to stay on continuously.

Push switch to the TIMER position at the desired time for the butterfly globe light to stay on for a continuous 6 hour period every day.

The globe light will turn on again the following day at the same time and turn off again 6 hours later. (For example: If you place the timer on at 5 p.m., it will turn off automatically at 11 p.m. It will continue to do this at the same time every day if you leave the switch in the Timer position.

Push button to the OFF position to switch butterfly globe light completely off.

NOTE:

To change starting time of timer, push button to the OFF and then back to ON/TIMER at the new desired time.

Changing the batteries

Open the battery compartment and insert batteries into the compartment observing the correct polarity. Push the battery compartment cover closed.

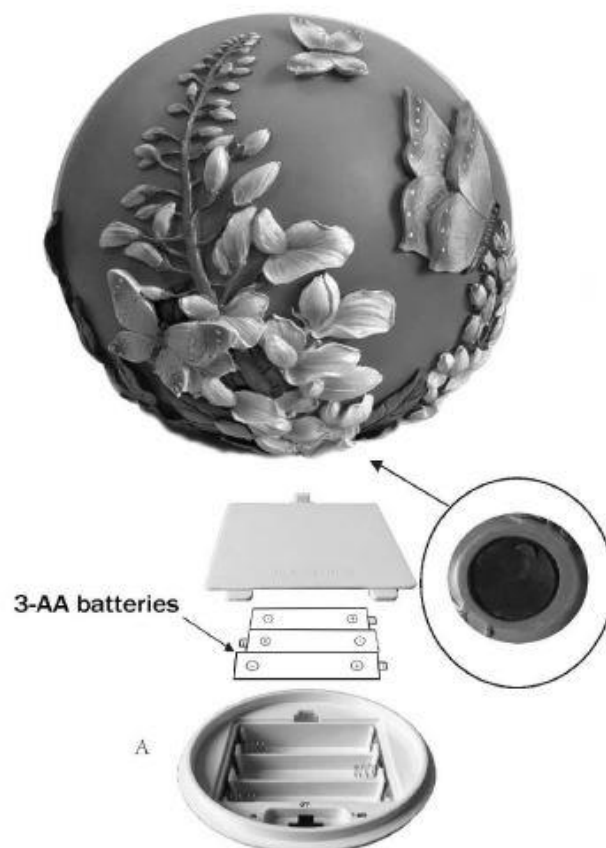
Maintenance

Turn off when not in use to save battery life.
