

- Do not attempt to assemble the awning if any parts are missing or damaged. In this case please contact our customer service.
- 6. Keep children and pets out of work area during assembly and adjustment.
- The awning and its fixing parts are only suitable for installation on a plain cement wall. If a wall shows cracks, you have to consult a qualified specialist.
- Please make sure that your hands are clean at the time of assembly, otherwise you may dirty the awning fabric and frame.
- 9. The operation in frosty conditions may damage the awning.
- Check the load-bearing capacity of the mounting base before assembly and if necessary, take corresponding measures to ensure stable installation of the brackets. Otherwise, the awning might not be stable, especially in windy, rainy, or snowy conditions.
- 11. Retract the fabric manually instead of rebounding it automatically by spring.
- Withdraw the awning and store it in a dry place when it is not in use for a long time, such as in winter.
- The awning should be kept away from fire and inflammable objects.
- 14. Please ensure safe and proper disposal of the awning and accessories to avoid harm.
