Installation

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging. The solar panel box can be positioned in the ground with the pointed stake. The stake should be pushed into the ground until it is firmly in place. To easily insert stakes into the ground, it is recommended to wet the ground first. To avoid damaging garden stakes when inserting into the ground, select a spot in soft, rock-free soil. Insert the base of the stake first then gently insert the rest of the stake into the base. DO NOT push directly against the solar cell or the ornament housing containing the actual LED light.

IMPORTANT:

- 1. Install the solar light in an area where it can get direct sunlight.
- 2. Leave the button to "ON" position.
- 1. Select an outdoor location away from other light sources at night, such as street lights. It may cause the product not to turn on automatically at night.
- 2. Duration of light depends on solar product's level of sunshine exposure, geographical locations, weather conditions and the hours of daylight.

CHANGING THE BATTERY:

- Only use replacement battery of the same type as stated above.
- Unscrew screws and remove bottom plate from the solar panel box.
- Remove the old battery.
- Replace a new battery; be certain to install the battery with the proper polarity. Replace the bottom plate and reinstall the screws.

BATTERIES

- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
