ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

Before first use

- Completely remove all packaging and labels.
- Clean the Cook & Drain Pot in hot soapy water to remove possible residues and dry completely.

Instructions for Use

The strainer can be used to wash and rinse your food the easy way. If you want to cook spaghetti please place the strainer on the bottom of the pot, fill 2/3 of the way with water, close with lid until the water is boiling, then add the spaghetti. Wait until the spaghetti is under water, using oven gloves take strainer and hang in the pins and cook. Do not cover the pot; traditional Italian pasta is cooked without a lid! When the spaghetti cooking time is ready take the pot by its handles, carefully tip it and drain off the water.

CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Leave the pot to cool down before cleaning. Do not immerse in or fill with cold water whilst hot.
- Do not use metal or abrasive clothes or brushes for cleaning.
- Dishwasher safe

Note

Slight signs of usage or scratches on the coating are normal and do not affect the function. The coating is such that it does not come off or splits. Even if accidentally swallowing small particles of the coating this is not dangerous. The particles are not poisonous and are completely harmless.

DISPOSAL

- Dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons, plastic and plastic bags in accordance with your local recycling regulations.
