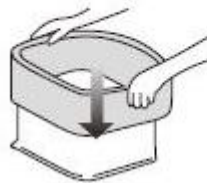
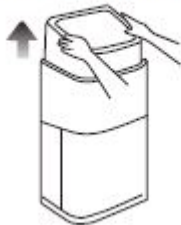


## Dimensions

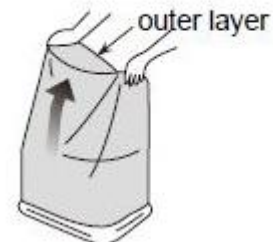

- DISCREET DESIGN
- RUBBER SEAL IN LID RESTRAINS ODOURS
- SIMPLY PLACE SOILED NAPKINS/SANITARY PRODUCTS IN THE TOP AND TO DISPOSE OPEN THE BOTTOM DOOR, PULL BAG AND PULL TOP THROUGH CLIP ON THE DOOR TO CUT AND THEN TIE TO CLOSE
- INCLUDES PRE-INSTALLED CONTINUOUS DISPOSAL BAG
- SET INCLUDES 1 BIN AND 3 REFILL BAGS (1 PRE-INSTALLED AT 2 ROLLS SEPARATE) AND SIMPLY CUT AT ANY LENGTH.
- 15L CAPACITY
- CLICK LOCK PRESS LID, OPENS AND CLOSSES WITH ONE TOUCH
- EASY TO USE
- MAGNETIC DOOR + LOCKABLE TOP LID.

1 Remove the inner oval ring 2 Place the refill bag on the ring



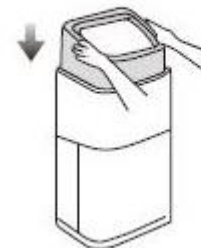
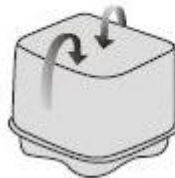
3 Pull the outer layer of the refill bag



4 Tie a knot to the bag



5 Flip the outer layer inward the ring 6 Put back the ring with refill bag



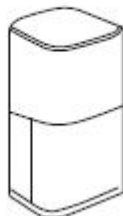

Commonly used for	Shopping bags, bread bags, squeeze bottles, stretch/pallet wrap, bubble wrap, multi-pack can holders	Microwaveable food containers, yoghurt pots, butter tubs, disposable plates and cups	CD's, crisp packets, various flexible packaging, baby bottles, sunglass lenses
Notes	Usually recyclable supermarket deposit points. Check other plastic films as any non-polythene film e.g. cling film, crisp packets film lids	Commonly recycled and collected from household recycling bins (packaging tape itself not recyclable but does not interfere with cardboard)	Not often or widely recycled
