





Battery installation


Important! Dry your hands before installing or replacing batteries.



1. Remove battery compartment cover. (Figure A)




Insert 4x AA batteries (not included) into the battery compartment. Make sure to line up the positive (+) and negative (-) markings on the battery compartment (Figure B).



Once the batteries are installed, put the battery cover back on (Figure C).

NOTE: Make sure the batteries are secure before reinstalling the battery cover to ensure optimal functionality.

HOW TO USE




1. Turn the Flex Cam on by holding down the power button (Figure D). The screen will become viewable when on.

To turn off the Flex Cam hold down the power button until screen is blank.

2. Position the camera at the end of the flexible cable (Figure E) to desired location for inspection. Slowly insert the flexible cable into inspection location. Do not apply force!

NOTE: The flexible cable can be bent into numerous shapes that may help you explore areas you otherwise thought were impossible to see.

3. Included are 3 attachments to help better view and retrieve objects from inspection locations (see "Attachment Installation" section.


Note: Do not point camera toward any person or property without their permission.

BATTERIES


