28cm(H) x6cm (base)

Requires 2x AAA batteries (not included)
LEDs not replaceable

- There are no open flames, no cords, and no need for electricity
- Slim tapered style does not take up a lot of room
- Flicker flames

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

Remove the bottom cover from the battery case. Insert 2xAAA batteries (not included), observing correct polarity. Twist the bulb cap to turn on. Turns off automatically 8 hours later. The candles will switch back on again every 24 hours.

CAUTIONS

- Do not place directly onto polished surfaces.
- Do not shine towards anyone's eyes.

CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Always switch off and remove batteries when not in use.
- Do NOT immerse in water.
- Do NOT use abrasive cleaners or sharp utensils to clean this appliance.
- Wipe surfaces with a soft dry cloth.
- Store the item in a cool, dry place.


BATTERIES

- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Install batteries in accordance with its polarity symbols.
- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
