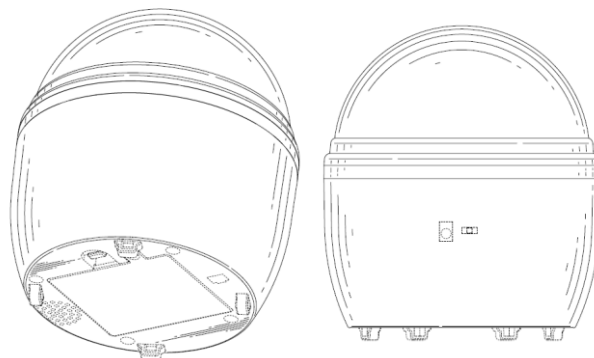

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

Operation:

- 1) The projector should be placed on a stable level surface. Open the battery case, replace batteries with 3 new AA batteries.
- 2) Set this device as a projector
- 3) Switch on, then will light up.
