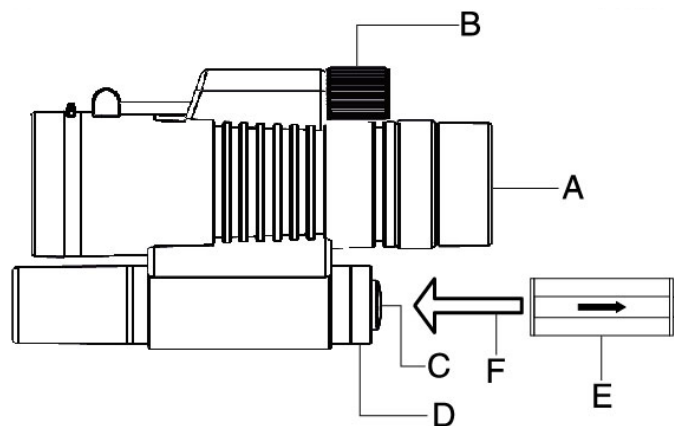

## User Instructions

### Parts



- To focus the scope, simply rotate the focusing ring (B) until your subject appears as sharp as possible. Keep one eye closed while you make this adjustment.
- The scope has now been adjusted to your open eye.

## Night Vision

- To emit the green wide angle laser, place batteries in the scope.
- To place batteries into the scope (uses 3x AAA batteries – not included), turn part (D) anti-clockwise and remove the battery holder (E) as indicated by the white arrow above (F).
- Press and hold button (C) for the laser to illuminate, release the button to turn off.

## Caution

- Do not look directly to light sources such as close viewing of automobile headlights.
- Viewing the sun can cause permanent eye damage. Do not look directly into the sun with this product.
- Do not use the laser in any manner other than that intended by the manufacturer to avoid exposure to hazardous laser.

## CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- To remove dirt or finger prints, use a soft cleaning cloth, moving in a circular motion. Use of a coarse cloth or unnecessary rubbing may scratch the surface and eventually cause permanent damage. A washable microfiber cleaning cloth is ideal for the routine cleaning of the scope. Simply breathe lightly on the lens to provide a slight amount of moisture, then gently rub lens with the microfiber cloth.
- Store your scope in a moisture-free area.

## Very important

**Never attempt to clean your scope internally or try to open it under any circumstances. No user serviceable parts.**


## BATTERIES

- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
