

User Instructions Parts



- To focus the scope, simply rotate the focusing ring (B) until your subject appears as sharp as possible. Keep one eye closed while you make this adjustment.
- The scope has now been adjusted to your open eye.

Night Vision

- To emit the green wide angle laser, place batteries in the scope.
- To place batteries into the scope (uses 3x AAA batteries not included), turn part (D) anti-clockwise and remove the battery holder (E) as indicated by the white arrow above (F).
- Press and hold button (C) for the laser to illuminate, release the button to turn off.


Never attempt to clean your scope internally or try to open it under any circumstances. No user serviceable parts.
