ABS

- WITH A PIVOTING HEAD YOU CAN POSITION IT AT THE PERFECT ANGLE NEEDED
- LED LIGHTS LAST UP TO 100,000 HOURS
- PUSH BUTTON ON/ OFF SWITCH

Each lamp is powered by 3x 1.5V DC AA batteries (not supplied)

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

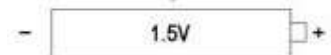
Requires 3x 1.5V 6 AA batteries (not included)

- Open the battery compartment lid
- Insert 3 AA batteries
- Replace the battery compartment lid.

On/Off button modes:

Press once to switch on

Press again to switch off



## CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Always switch off and remove batteries when not in use.
- Do not shine light directly towards eyes.
- Do NOT immerse in water.
- Do NOT use abrasive cleaners or sharp utensils to clean this appliance.
- Store the item in a cool, dry place.
