## Before you start

Carefully measure the area you wish to cover to ensure you have the correct quantity of artificial grass.

## How To Use

1. Remove any existing grass and weeds, rake the topsoil to remove rocks and stones, compact the subbase, by treading or using a garden roller.
2. Lay out the grass roll. Ideally, leave for a few hours (up to 24) to let creases come out, and gently stretch the roll to ensure it is not buckled.
3. Trim edges to fit the area required using long scissors or a sharp safety knife. Ensure the grass pile is running in the same direction if using rolls side by side in larger areas.
4. Fold the trimmed edges over and put joint tape (not provided) below the edges.
5. Using landscape staples or lawn tape (not provided) help to install the grass to a neat finish, available from most DIY stores or on line.

- When finished, we recommend spreading some sharp sand on the artificial grass, simply spread evenly by hand and brush in with a stiff bristle brush. Do NOT do this if the lawn is damp or wet, wait for it to dry.

### How to Maintain and Keep it Looking Great


- To ensure that your artificial turf remains in good and pristine condition throughout the year, regular maintenance is required. To give your grass a refresh throughout the year use our range of fake rakes G306 and F784.
- At the very least, to ensure the durability and resilience of your artificial lawn, regularly brush off dirt, dirt, or debris. You should also clean your new surface to remove any dust after installing the artificial grass. Do not spray or pressure wash as this will remove any existing fillings.
- Use a rigid natural bristle brush regularly to help keep the fibres straight and even, creating a long-lasting and healthy artificial lawn. Avoid using a hard metal brush or metal rake, as this can tear the grass, creating unsightly cracks and holes
- You should avoid snuffing out cigarettes on the grass. Doing so not only destroys the fibres of the artificial grass, it also creates a nasty smell when the plastic melts.
- To ensure that upright, elastic grass fibres recover quickly after use, do not place any heavy objects on the grass. Heavy items such as cars, large gardening tools or motorcycles can also damage the soil below and can drip with oil, permanently staining the lawn.

**Additional advice for dog owners** - Don't let your dog dig or pull edges on surfaces. We recommend removing any pet fouling as soon as possible, and if necessary, flush the area with a hose and brush gently. Finally, unlike natural turf, if necessary, a disinfectant can be used on artificial turf to kill any potentially harmful bacteria.
