## Dimensions

(12.2-19.5)\*11cm

- SMART SPACE SAVING STORAGE CONTAINERS THAT ALSO KEEP FOOD FRESH FOR LONGER
- VACUUMS AIR OUT AND KEEPS FRESHNESS IN
- USE WITH DRY OR FRESH FOODS LIKE CEREAL, OATS, RICE, PASTA, VEGETABLES AND MORE
- DOUBLE IN CAPACITY 700-1500 GRAM CAPACITY
- USE IN FRIDGE/CUPBOARDS
- DISHWASHER SAFE

## User Instructions

- Always make sure the presser and cover are secured properly and screwed on tightly before pressing.
- Do not over-tighten the lid or overfill the container.

## Note:

The container is recommended for dry goods. It is not recommended to store liquid in it as liquid may come out from the one-way valve when you press it down.

## Cleaning

- Hand wash recommended. Do not microwave or store in the freezer.
- Top rack dishwasher safe Instructions: Wash with warm soapy water, rinse, and dry the container before using it for the first time.

## DISPOSAL

- Coopers of Stortford use recyclable or recycled packaging where possible.
- Please dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons, packaging in accordance with your local recycling regulations.
