ALWAYS POSITION IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT FOR BEST CHARGING



Dimensions

17 (L) x13 (W) x27cm (H)

Contains 1 x AAA rechargeable battery – 600mAh NiMH

- SITTING PROUD AT 27CM HIGH WITH ITS STAINED GLASS WINGS IN FULL FLEDGE THEY WILL SPARKLE IN THE SUNLIGHT AND ILLUMINATE AT NIGHT
- FREE STANDING SO YOU CAN POSITION ON A FENCE TOP, TABLE TOP, WINDOW SILL ETC
- WARM WHITE LED AUTOMATICALLY ILLUMINATES AT NIGHT TIME
- SOLAR POWERED

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

The ON/OFF switch is located at the bottom of the light next to the battery compartment.

Turn to ON to switch the light on.
Turn to OFF to switch the light off.

The solar light has a light sensor so when the lamp is switched on the light will start automatically and light up all dark areas located near the lamp.

For first time use, it will take a full day of sunlight to fully charge the battery.

Install the solar product in an area where it can get direct sunlight.

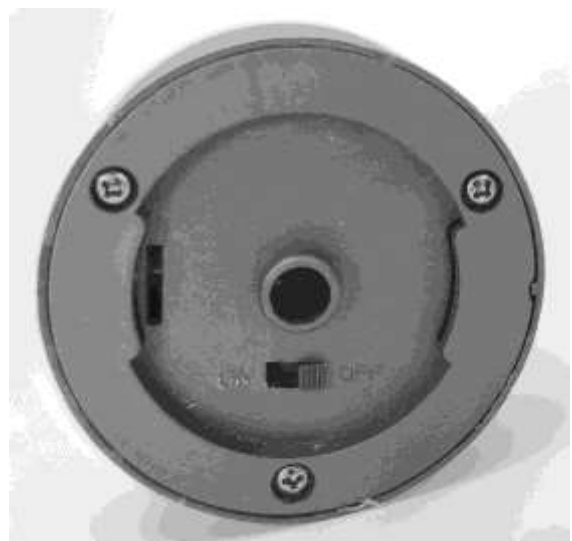
Leave the switch to "ON" position.

Select an outdoor location away from other light sources at night, such as street lights. It may cause the product not to turn on automatically at night.

Duration of light depends on solar product's level of sunlight exposure, geographical locations, weather conditions and the hours of daylight.

CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Always switch off and remove batteries when not in use.
- Do NOT immerse in water.
- Do NOT use abrasive cleaners or sharp utensils to clean.
- Regularly clean solar panel with a damp cloth.
