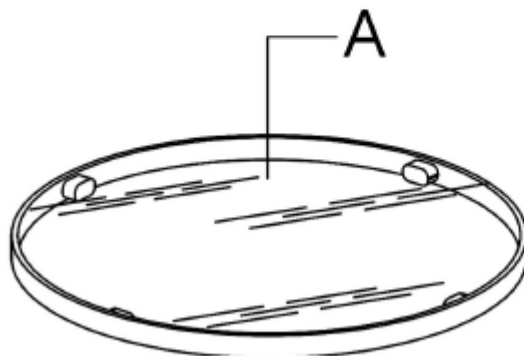

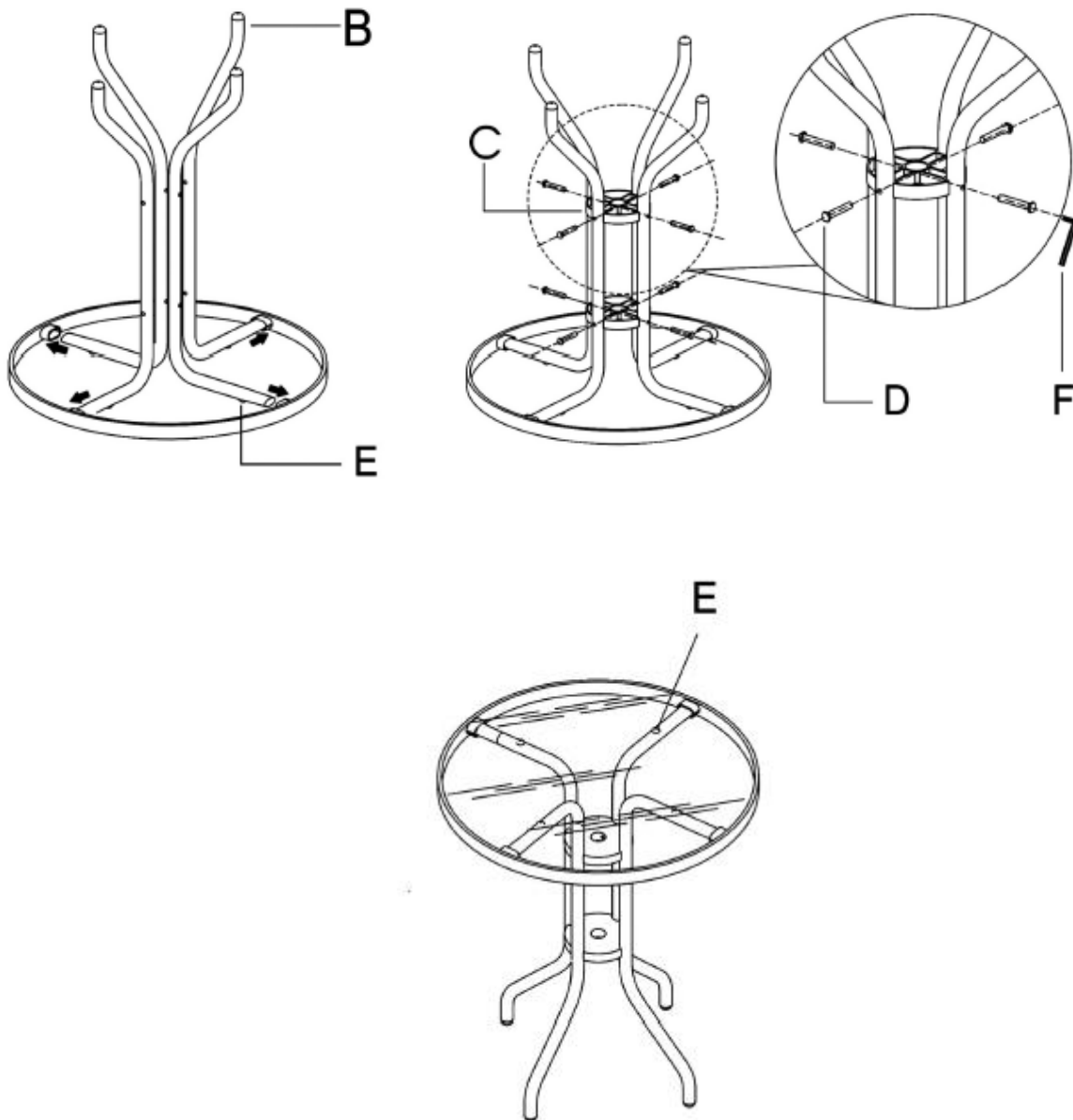

Maintenance Recommendations

1. Always make sure all the bolts and screws are secured and tight this will stop putting stress on the item. Do this regularly over the year.
2. Over the winter months wash down metal furniture with warm soapy water and use non – abrasive cloth or sponge before rinsing and drying.
3. It is recommended to cover your garden furniture over the winter months.
4. If you have room bring the garden furniture inside over the winter months.
5. Always try and place your garden furniture on level surfaces.
6. Please check and carry out maintenance on a regular basis to check security of fixings and tighten if loose before use.
7. Check your furniture after windy spell of weather.
