CAUTION:

- Do not use or try to erect in windy conditions – this may cause injury or damage to the Sail Shade.
- Keep your hands away from moving parts as the frame opens and closes to avoid pinching.
- Minimum of 2 Persons required to erect.

Garden Furniture Maintenance Recommendations

1. Always make sure all the bolts and screws are secured and tight this will stop putting stress on the item. Do this regularly over the year.
2. Over the winter months wash down metal furniture with warm soapy water and use non – abrasive cloth or sponge before rinsing and drying.
3. Bring the standing sail shade to store inside over the winter months.
4. Always try and place your garden furniture on level surfaces.
5. You can carry out maintenance on your garden furniture any time.
6. Check your furniture after windy spell of weather.

DISPOSAL

- Coopers of Stortford use recyclable or recycled packaging where possible.

Code & Symbol	 LDPE	 PP
Type of Plastic	Low Density Polyethylene	Polypropylene
Commonly used for	Shopping bags, bread bags, squeeze bottles, stretch/pallet wrap, bubble wrap, multi-pack can holders	Microwaveable food containers, yoghurt pots, butter tubs, disposable plates and cups
Notes	Usually recyclable supermarket deposit points. Check other plastic films as any non-polythene film e.g. cling film, crisp packets film lids	Commonly recycled and collected from household recycling bins (packaging tape itself not recyclable but does not interfere with cardboard)

- At the end of the product’s lifespan please check with your local council authorised household waste recycling centre for disposal.
