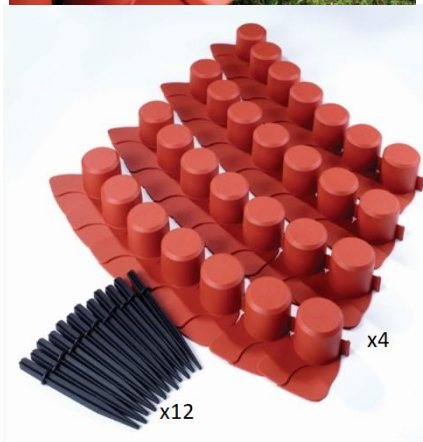


Pk 4 Mow Over Lawn Edging

Dimensions

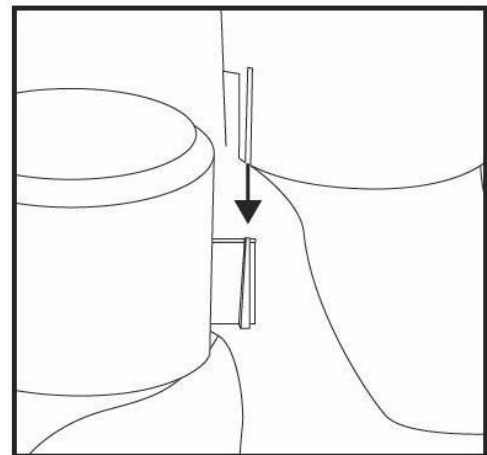
54.5 x11 x6cm (1 pack length just over 2 meters)

- LOG SHAPED FLEXIBLE LAWN EDGING
- MADE OF STRONG AND DURABLE PP PLASTIC
- SEAMLESS INTERLOCKING SECTIONS THAT YOU CAN POSITION EITHER STRAIGHT OR CURVED SO IT IS SUITABLE FOR ALL LAWN SHAPES
- PROVIDES A NEAT BORDER AROUND YOUR LAWN EDGES AND MEANS YOU NO LONGER HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT TEDIOUS EDGE TRIMMING
- WHAT'S MORE YOU DON'T EVEN NEED TO WORRY ABOUT REMOVING IT WHEN MOWING YOUR LAWN THANKS TO THE FLAT EDGES THAT ARE SAFE TO MOW OVER
- IT CAN EVEN HELP PREVENT WEED TRANSFER TO AND FROM DIFFERENT SECTIONS OF YOUR GARDEN
- SIMPLY TAP INTO THE GROUND WITH THE GROUND STAKES INCLUDED
- YOU CAN INTERLOCK AS MANY SECTIONS AS YOU WOULD LIKE

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

Connect sections as shown and insert stakes as shown.



To easily insert stakes into the ground, it is recommended to wet the ground first. To avoid damaging garden stakes when inserting into the ground, select a spot in soft, rock-free soil. Insert the base of the stake first then gently insert the rest of the stake into the base. DO NOT push directly against the solar cell or the ornament housing containing the actual LED light.
