
## Dimensions

59 x 1 x 16cm (59 x 1 x 27 cm including stake)

- CUTE OWL DESIGN LAWN EDGING
- EACH PACK CONTAINS 4 PANELS EACH ARE 59CM WIDE, SO EACH PACK GIVES YOU 236CM OF LAWN EDGING
- EACH PANEL SIMPLY INTERLOCKS
- USING THE GROUND STAKES SIMPLY PUSH INTO THE GROUND TO SECURE
- QUICK AND EASY TO INSTALL
- LINE ALONG FLOWER BEDS, PATHS, GARDEN BORDERS ETC TO NEATEN AND FINISH OFF YOUR GARDEN
- WEATHER RESISTANT

Snap pieces together and attach stakes.

To easily insert stakes into the ground, it is recommended to wet the ground first.  
To avoid damaging garden stakes when inserting into the ground, select a spot in soft, rock-free soil. Insert the base of the stake first then gently insert the rest of the stake into the base.

Type of Plastic	Low Density Polyethylene	Polypropylene
Commonly used for	Shopping bags, bread bags, squeeze bottles, stretch/pallet wrap, bubble wrap, multi-pack can holders	Microwaveable food containers, yoghurt pots, butter tubs, disposable plates and cups
Notes	Usually recyclable supermarket deposit points. Check other plastic films as any non-polythene film e.g. cling film, crisp packets film lids	Commonly recycled and collected from household recycling bins (packaging tape itself not recyclable but does not interfere with cardboard)

At the end of the product's lifespan please check with your local council authorised household waste recycling centre for disposal.
