

# 3 in 1 Garden Clear Up set

- **3 IN 1 BROOM SET**
- **SWEEP AWAY YOUR WORRIES OF AN UNTIDY GARDEN**
- **USE THE CURVED BROOM HEAD FOR SWEEPING UP LEAVES, DEBRIS ETC, TOUGH FLAT BROOM HEAD FOR SCRUBBING AWAY MOSS ETC ON PATIO & DECKING, SMALL BRUSH HEAD FOR REMOVING WEEDS & MOSS FROM IN BETWEEN CRACKS/ PATIO SLABS ETC, IT ALSO HAS A STAINLESS STEEL HOOK ON ONE END FOR REALLY TOUGH WEEDS AND MOSS**
- **THE ONLY TOOL YOU WILL NEED FOR TIDYING UP YOUR GARDEN BEFORE WINTER!**
- **THE HANDLE EXTENDS FROM 80- 140CM**
- **CURVED BROOM HEAD 30\*15\*9CM**
- **SCRAPER AND BRUSH HEAD 41\*9\*5CM**
- **WEED BRUSH HEAD 13\*10\*4cm**

## Assembly instructions

Insert the screwed end into the head until you can feel resistance. Then, keeping pressure on, screw the pole clockwise into the head until the "click-stop" locks it into place.

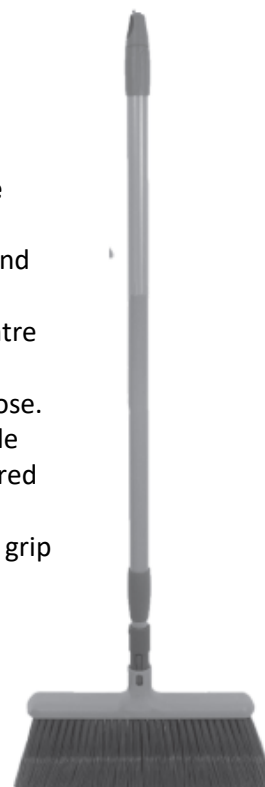
### To remove the head

Press the 2 click-stop buttons below the head either side of the pole and screw head in reverse.



### To extend the pole

Holding the head end of the pole in one hand, twist the centre grip anti-clockwise until it becomes loose. Then adjust the pole length to the required height. Tighten by twisting the centre grip clockwise.
