

Features:

- The emergency lights has built-in long life and rechargeable 18650 Li-ion batteries of high capacity as 2x1200mAH
- The battery can be charged and discharged more than 500 times.
- SMD chip is in advantages of energy-saving, high light, long life and high power.
- Both high light and dim light for choices

Instruction:

- Please use the USB cord line connect the light USB port and the USB charger. The USB charger (not included) should be 5V 500mAH or 5V 1A.
- Push the switch up, Low light will be ON, then push the switch up again, high light will be ON, push the switch down 2 steps, the light will be OFF. When you need use USB to recharge or charge to the phone, please push the switch to the bottom.
- The charging port is red and blue flickering to show it is being charged.
- Before using the unit for the first time. It should be charged for about 25 hours.

The light can last for 2 hours after fully charged on high light setting, 3.5-4 hours on low light setting.

The SMD will get progressively darker which means the battery is discharging. At this moment, please stop using and charge the light. Please do not start charging until the SMD is entirely dark, as this will cause damage to the battery electrode.

The emergency light should be used and charged frequently. Please charge it for about 8-12 hours at least every 3 months or the life time of battery will change. Charge the unit regularly for 8-12 hours to avoid battery drain.
