LEDs not replaceable

- The device should be kept out of the reach of children. This is not a toy. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.
- Never immerse this device in water.
- Do not get the device wet and keep it away from water and heat.
- Do not use the device if the USB cable is damaged. Do not twist or wrap the cable around the device.
- This appliance is intended exclusively for domestic use.
- The device is for indoor use only.

Use

- Touch the ON OFF button to turn the device on, to change the light intensity and to turn it off. There are 3 lighting levels. To change just slightly tap the base.
- The device is charged by USB cable or 3 AAA batteries (not provided).

Cleaning:

- Wipe the device with a slightly damp cloth after unplugging it.



BATTERIES

- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
