BEFORE FIRST USE

Before using your new baking tins, please read the following instructions and keep for future reference. Remove all labels.

Before using, wash your baking tins in warm, soapy water then rinse and dry thoroughly. This will remove any residue that is left over from manufacturing and packaging of your new purchase.

- Keep small children away from the baking area while you are baking. Heat, steam, hot food and oils can splatter from baking tin when in use.
- These baking tins are not intended for commercial use.
- Oven safe 210°C.
- Not suitable for Microwave use.
- Not suitable for dishwasher use.
- Never cut food in the baking tins.
- To ensure the longer life of your non-stick baking tins, it is recommended to only use wooden or nylon utensils.

- With use, slight surface marks, abrasions and discolouration are normal and will not affect the non-stick performance of the surface.
- DO NOT place baking tins on stove top or allow direct contact with flame.

CLEANING FOR NON-STICK

- After baking DO NOT immerse your hot tin in cold water as this may result in irreversible warping.
- Always let the baking tins cool to room temperature before cleaning.
- To prevent scratches, never scrub your baking tins with a steel wool pad or any harsh abrasive cleaners.
- Baking tins are recommended to wash in warm soapy water using a soft sponge or soft brush.



CAUTION:

- **Always use an oven mitt or glove when removing from oven.**
- **Not suitable for dishwasher use.**

DISPOSAL

- Coopers of Stortford use recyclable or recycled packaging where possible.
- Please dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons, packaging in accordance with your local recycling regulations.
- Plastics, polybags – this is made from the following recyclable plastic.

Notes	Not usually collected from household recycling bins, Sometimes recycled at local waste management centres.	Usually recyclable supermarket deposit points. Check other plastic films as any non-polythene film e.g. cling film, crisp packets film lids
