## Dimensions

(H) 40 x (W) 30 x (D) 1.8cm

- REQUIRES 2 X AA BATTERIES (NOT INCLUDED)
- 6 LED LIGHT (not replaceable): AT NIGHT WHEN THE LIGHTS DIM, IT CREATES A LOVELY EXTRA GLOWING DIMENSION WITH ITS OWN TWINKLY 6 LED LIGHTS
- CANVAS MAKE IDEAL EASY CHRISTMAS DECORATION, SIMPLY TAKE AN EXISTING PICTURE DOWN FOR THE DURATION OF THE FESTIVE SEASON AND POP THE CANVAS UP, THEN STORE AWAY ALONG WITH YOUR CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS UNTIL NEXT YEAR
- FEATURES A CHRISTMAS SCENE.
- LED LIGHTS BRIGHTEN UP YOUR WALLS

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

### INSTALL/REPLACE BATTERIES

- Lift the black cloth under the back of the wall painting. You will see the battery case without cover.
- Remove or replace the batteries.
- Install 2x AA batteries.

### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Handle with care.
- Always switch off and remove batteries when not in use.
- Do NOT immerse in water.
- Store the item in a cool, dry place and away from children.
- Wipe with a clean dry cloth.

### BATTERIES

- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
