ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

How to use Microwave Madge

- 1. Remove the top by twisting Microwave Madge's hair clockwise and pull up the head completely.
- 2. Fill Microwave Madge with a mixture of vinegar and water. The markers for levels of vinegar and water to be used are on the outside of the body. Replace the top and twist to lock in place.
- 3. Microwave for 5-8 minutes on a high setting. After about 2 minutes steam will start to blast out.
- 4. Remove Microwave Madge from the microwave holding it by the elbows/handles only.
- 5. Wipe down any food stains or residue in the microwave with a sponge, napkin or cloth.

How to use Fridge Freshening Flora

- 1. Remove the top by twisting the hair and head clockwise.
- 2. Put baking soda in the bottle up to the line. Put back together.
- 3. Set the dial on the top of her head for a month's date. Place it in the fridge.
- 4. In 1-3 months remove her from your fridge (duration depends on the size of your fridge). Rinse the bottle with warm water.
