ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

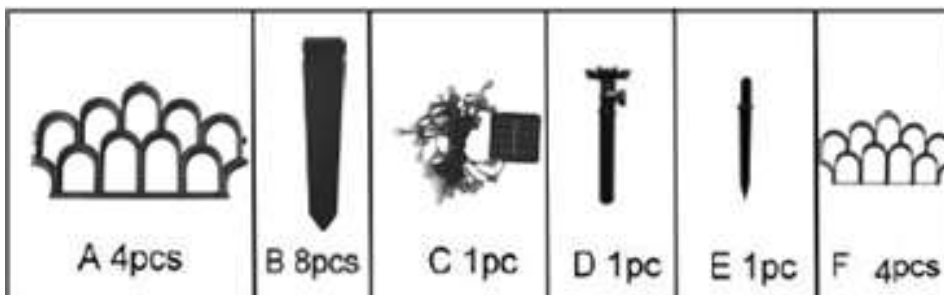
Before using first time

Allow lights to charge for at least 8 hours in full sunlight with the ON/OFF switch in the ON position. The ON/OFF switch is located under the solar panel. Once the batteries are fully charged, set the ON/OFF switch to ON. If the lamp does not turn on after dark refer to Maintenance section.

Find an ideal Place for the Solar Light.

Place the solar light in an area where it will receive direct sunlight for at least 8 hours per day. The number of hours the light will illuminate is directly proportional to the hours of sunlight it receives. If the light is placed in a shaded area, it will not be able to fully charge and its illumination time will be limited. Do not place the light near other outdoor lighting like porch or streetlights. These may fool the sensor and keep the light from coming on, or cause it to turn off automatically

Parts



BEFORE FIRST USE: Remove the protective film from the solar panel.

CHARGING AND OPERATION:

1. Set button (located underneath solar panel) to "ON" position. Charge the solar product by placing it under direct sunlight for at least 8 hours.
2. The light will work automatically. It will automatically charge under direct sunlight during the daytime and illuminate at night.

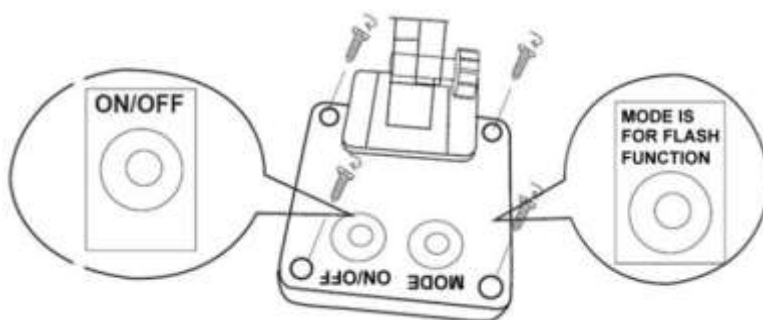

3. Set "ON/OFF" button to "ON" position for steady on light, press the "MODE" button to activate flash light function. If you like to go back to steady on light, then press "MODE" button again to deactivate flash light.

NOTE: In order to verify that the button is correctly in the "ON" position, cover the solar panel with your hand and the light should turn "ON" automatically.



TROUBLESHOOTING

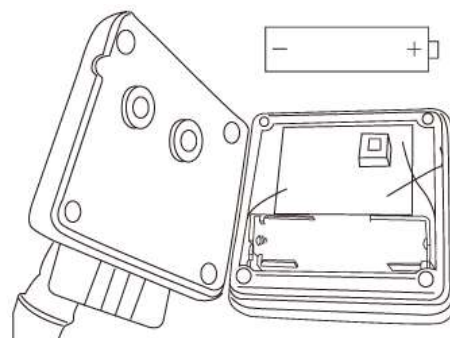
Make sure the button is set to "ON" position and keep the solar panel clean. If solar product does not light up after it has been used for around 8 – 12 months, replace the rechargeable batteries as they may be weak or worn out. (Battery 1pc "AA" 1.2V 300mAh, Ni-MH, Rechargeable– Same equivalent type as recommended must be used).

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

Step1: Unscrew the battery compartment cover by using a Phillips head screwdriver (not included).

Step2: Remove the exhausted battery and install 1pc new AA rechargeable battery according to the +/- symbol polarity indicated on the battery compartment. Open the compartment carefully and ensure that welding wires inside the battery terminals are not damaged.

Step3: Replace battery compartment cover, screw it back into position and ensure is properly sealed.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

To easily insert stakes into the ground, it is recommended to wet the ground first. To avoid damaging garden stakes when inserting into the ground, select a spot in soft, rock-free soil. Insert the base of the stake first then gently insert the rest of the stake into the base. DO NOT push directly against the solar cell or the ornament housing containing the actual LED light.

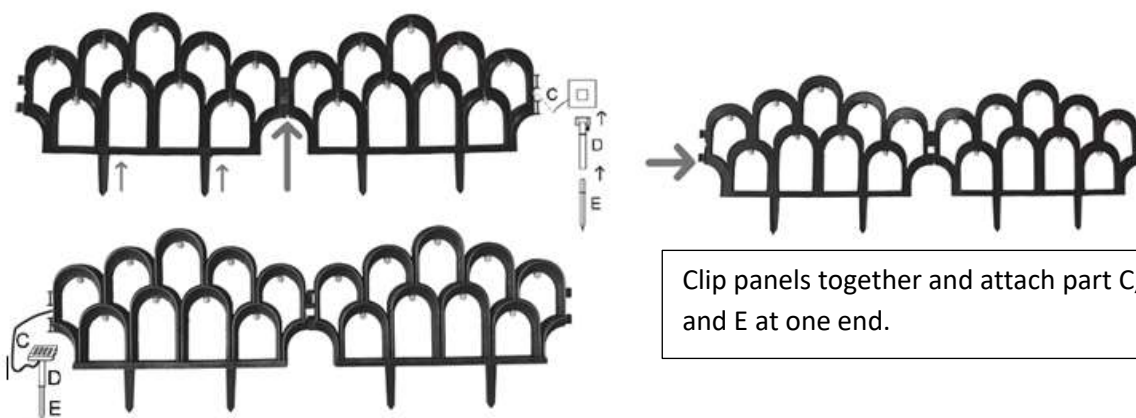
1. The bulbs and stakes need to be assembled first. Push the bulb into place then move onto the next bulb. Affix total of 9 lights one after the other. Press each one down until it locks (see image). When all bulbs are in place (36), fit the backing section and clip into place, press down to lock them. Make sure it is clipped in place then turn the panel over and push the bulb in to place. Then move on to the next panel.
2. Slide the stakes into the holes
3. Connect the panels.

Clip panels together and attach part C, D and E at one end.

Care and Maintenance Recommendations

1. Clean solar panel with a soft sponge every couple of weeks.
2. Make sure all connectors are still tight and no water getting in.
3. During the winter if you can bring it inside and give a good clean ready for next year.
