Instructions

- Remove the string lights from the lantern and remove the cover from the battery case. Insert 2x AA batteries (not included), observing correct polarity, as shown inside the battery case.
- Replace cover and turn the switch on the battery compartment. Then return the string lights to the lantern.

CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- Always switch off before cleaning.
- Do NOT immerse in water. Risk of electric shock.
- Do NOT use abrasive cleaners or sharp utensils to clean this appliance.
- Wipe surfaces with a soft dry cloth.
