2x AA Batteries required (not included)

## Dimensions

(W) 30 x (D) 6 x (L) 30cm

- SOOTHE COLD, TIRED AND ACHING FEET WITH A WARMING FOOT MASSAGE
- RELIEVE TIRED ACHING MUSCLES
- KEEP FEET WARM AND TREAT THEM TO A GENTLE MASSAGE
- SOFT FOAM CUSHION WITH 2 GENEROUS SIZED PLUSH POCKETS FOR YOUR FEET
- 2 SPEED VIBRATION MODES, CHOOSE THE RIGHT AMOUNT OF RELIEF FOR YOU
- SIMPLE ON OFF SWITCH
- FOAM FILLING, FLEECE OUTER

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

**ALWAYS USE ALKALINE BATTERIES.  
DO NOT USE LITHIUM BATTERIES.**

### Battery installation

(2x AA batteries are required – not included)

- Locate the battery compartment by unzipping the pillow cover.
  - Slide off the cover of the battery compartment.
- Note: Use caution not to damage the wire connectors.
- Insert 2x AA batteries, making sure to follow the polarity diagram imprinted on the inside of the battery compartment.
  - Replace the compartment cover.
  - Zip pillow cover.



### Using your Vibration Foot Massager

- Position the pillow on the floor.
- Insert your feet into the left and right foot pocket located on the top of the pillow.
- Turn the pillow on by pressing the power/mode button on the left side of the pillow. There are 2 different modes I and II.
- Turn unit off after use.
