- **GENTLE EAR CLEANERS**

Batteries required: 2x AA (not included) (per unit) ALWAYS USE ALKALINE BATTERIES. DO NOT USE LITHIUM BATTERIES.

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

- Never use without the silicone attachments
- Wash thoroughly before and after each use

User Instructions:

- 1. Insert 2x AA batteries (not included) as shown:
- 2. Wash your hands thoroughly
- 3. Slide a silicone attachment (larger diameter in first) onto the small tube located in the front of the ear cleaner. There are four different colour silicone attachments for multiple users
- 4. Slide the ON/OFF switch to the ON position
- 5. Insert the tube with the silicone attachment into your ear, slightly turn the ear cleaner to help draw out the wax.



How To Clean:

- Place silicone attachments in warm soapy water
- Unsnap the front piece with the small tube from the main unit and place in warm soapy water
- Remove the screen (by pulling away from the main unit) and place in warm soapy water
- Scrub each piece using the small brush provided to remove any debris
- Dry each piece thoroughly using a dry cloth

BATTERIES

- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
