## Dimensions

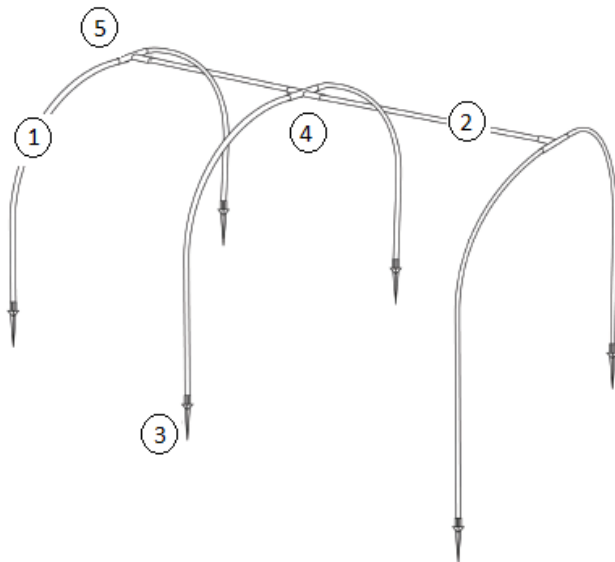

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.



## Parts

Part 1 x 6  
Part 2 x 2  
Part 3 x 6  
Part 4 x 1  
Part 5 x 2

Connect parts as shown in the diagram

To easily insert stakes into the ground, it is recommended to wet the ground first. To avoid damaging garden stakes when inserting into the ground, select a spot in soft, rock-free soil. Insert the base of the stake first then gently insert the rest of the stake into the base.

Once assembled, position cover on top of the frame.

The small door at the end of the tunnel can be opened for ventilation or shut to keep in the moisture.


You can also roll up the sides and hold open with ties when watering the plants.
