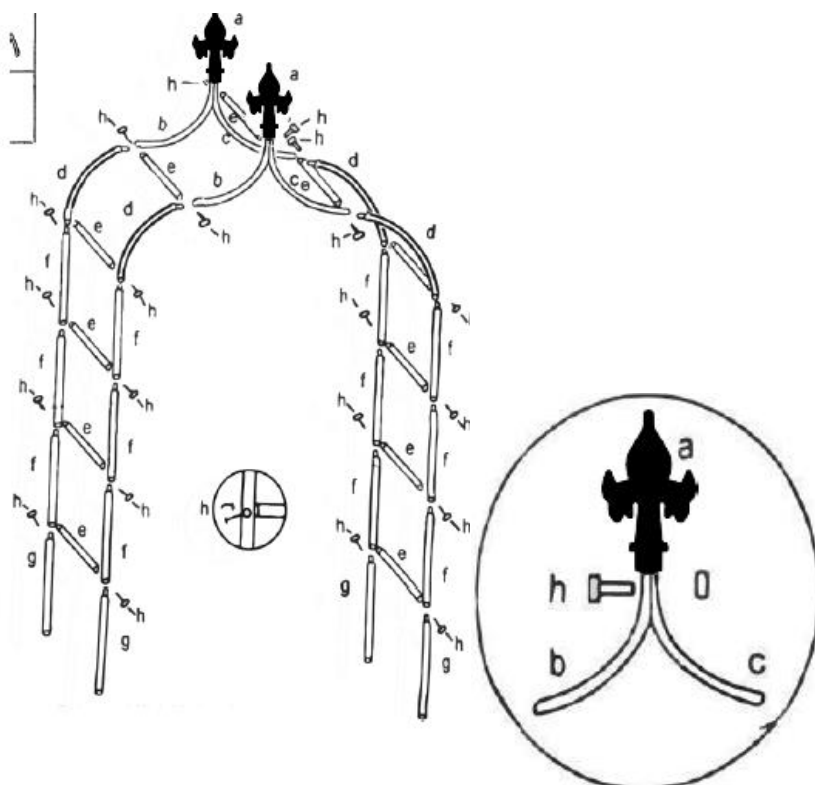
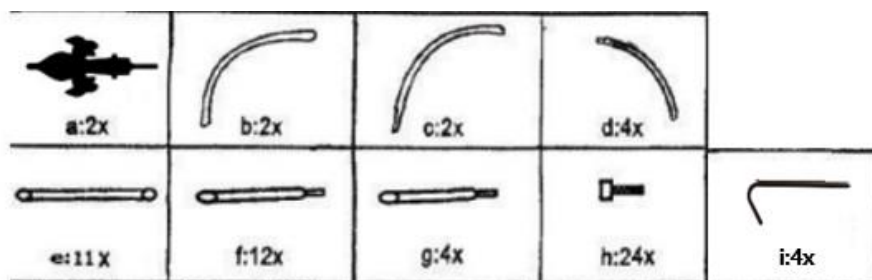

Instructions for use:

1. Assemble 4 pcs (g) and 4 pcs (f) to 2 pcs (e) together by the Bolt (h).
2. Assemble 4 pcs (f) and 4 pcs (f) to 2 pcs (e) together by the Bolt (h).
3. Assemble 2 pcs (b), 2 pcs (c) and 2 pcs (a) to 1 pc € together by the bolt (h).
4. Assemble 4 pcs (d) to 2 pcs € together by Bolt (h).
5. Connect the three assemblies together with the Tube (e) by the both (h) to form the completed arch.
6. Take 4pcs (i) through the holes of 4pcs (g), and insert them into ground so as to fix the arch.

CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Do NOT use abrasive cleaners or sharp utensils to clean this product.
- Store the item in a cool, dry place.
- Wipe with a clean dry cloth.
- to prevent damage to the product, the screws and fittings may be taped to the inner packaging.
- Please examine the contents of the packaging carefully before disposal.
- Avoid distorting the shape or moving it vigorously as this could overstress the joints.
- When assembled, the Arch should be located firmly in the ground to a depth which gives sufficient stability. A depth of 4 - 8 inches (0.1 - 0.2 m) is suitable.
- If you encounter difficulty in connecting tubes together, try interchanging other components of the same type.
- In some cases, light application of lubricating oil may assist with tube connection.

Warnings and cautions:

- To simplify assembly, please read through the full instructions before commencing.
- Do not fully tighten the bolts until you are sure all component parts are assembled.
- When transporting the completed Arch or lifting it in an upright position, seek assistance of others to support the two vertical sections and the Arch sections and carefully place it in the final position.

DISPOSAL

- Coopers of Stortford use recyclable or recycled packaging where possible.
- Please dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons in accordance with your local authority recycling regulations.
- At the end of the product's lifespan please check with your local council authorised household waste recycling centre for disposal.
