Precautions for safe use

Please follow the steps in this manual to install the machine. Keep this manual properly. If you provide this machine to a third party, please include this manual with the machine. Any operation inconsistent with the instructions in this manual may cause product damage or serious personal injury. This machine is only suitable for operation in a regular home environment and is not suitable for use in an industrial environment or outdoors.

① This machine is not suitable for people with physical, sensory or intellectual disabilities or those who lack experience and common sense (including children) unless they are supervised or guided by others to ensure that they can be used safely.

② Do not touch the plug or any live part of the product with wet hands to avoid the risk of electric shock.

③ If the charger or power cord is damaged, please stop using it immediately. Please call our after-sales personnel for replacement to avoid harm.

- ④ Please keep the airflow channels, rotating and movable parts of this machine away from long hair, loose clothing, fingers and other parts of the body. Do not point the vacuum hose and accessories towards your eyes, ears, or put them into your mouth.
- ⑤ If this product is not used for a long time, the power should be turned off.
- ⑥ If this machine cannot work properly because it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors or dropped into water, please do not take it out for operation. Please contact our company's professional maintenance personnel for repairs in time to avoid danger and personal injury.
- ⑦ During use, if you find leakage or excessive motor temperature or abnormal noise, such as overheating of the body, strange sounds, odors, weak suction, etc., you should stop using it immediately and call our company's professional maintenance personnel.
- ⑧ After unpacking this machine, please immediately dispose of the packaging bags used by the packaging machine to avoid the risk of suffocation when children play.
- ⑨ Do not place the machine outdoors or store it in a place that may freeze, and do not place the product near a heat source.
- ⑩ Do not expose the machine to fire or high temperature to avoid product damage or explosion risk.
- ⑪ After using the machine, please clean the sewage tank in time and keep the ventilation path open to avoid blockage, which will cause the suction to decrease and the motor to heat up, thus affecting the service life of the fabric cleaning machine.
- ⑫ After using the machine, please store it in a dry place. Humid places will affect the insulation and service life of electrical appliances.
- ⑬ The fabric cleaning machine has a power-on setting and cannot be soaked in water or rinsed. Please check the smoothness of the suction nozzle regularly. If there is any blockage, please clear it in time to avoid the blockage causing a decrease in suction power and affecting the performance of the machine.
- ⑭ Please make sure to shut down the machine before replacing the roller brush. When the machine fails, do not repair it yourself. Repairs must be carried out by professional maintenance personnel recognized by our company or please call our after-sales department for help.
- ⑮ Do not disassemble or assemble the closed machine by yourself. There are no customer-repairable parts in this machine, and do not try to change the performance of the machine, otherwise it will cause danger.
- ⑯ Using a voltage that does not correspond to the specifications of this product will damage the motor and may even cause harm to the user. The correct rated voltage is marked on the nameplate.

⑰ To prevent tripping, the machine should be placed against a wall after use. Do not use the clean water bucket and wastewater bucket if they are not installed correctly. Do not place any small objects on the air outlet, and do not block the air outlet. Remove any small objects that may hinder the smooth air flow of the air outlet to prevent the machine from overheating.

About the scope of use of the product

① This product is suitable for flat surfaces such as porcelain tiles in indoor environments, and is suitable for cleaning short-pile carpets.

② Do not use this product near or on the surface of flammable or explosive objects, as there is a risk of fire and explosion.

③ Do not use this product near a working fireplace or heater to prevent the machine shell from deforming.

④ Do not smoke high-temperature substances (unextinguished cigarette butts, matches or hot ashes, etc.), ultra-fine substances (such as lime, cement, sawdust, gypsum powder, ashes, carbon powder, etc.), dangerous items (such as solvents, descalers, etc.) etc.), chemical substances (such as acids, detergents, etc.) and other substances with uncertain physical properties.

⑤ Do not use this fabric cleaning machine to absorb detergent, kerosene, gasoline, alcohol, paint, perfume, etc. These liquids may cause a short circuit, fire or explosion in the machine.

⑥ Do not use this fabric cleaning machine to absorb toner and toner used inside laser printers and copiers. These objects may cause fire or explosion.

⑦ Do not use this fabric cleaning machine to pick up sharp objects, such as glass fragments, small toys, pins, paper clips, stones, plaster, large pieces of paper, etc. These objects may cause blockage and damage the machine.

⑧ Do not use this fabric cleaning machine to absorb any burning or smoking objects, such as cigarette ashes that have not extinguished the heat source, burning cigarette butts or matches, etc. Stains with strong grease, strong stickiness or strong dyeing properties, such as shoe polish, paint, and pigments, are not within the scope of use of this product.

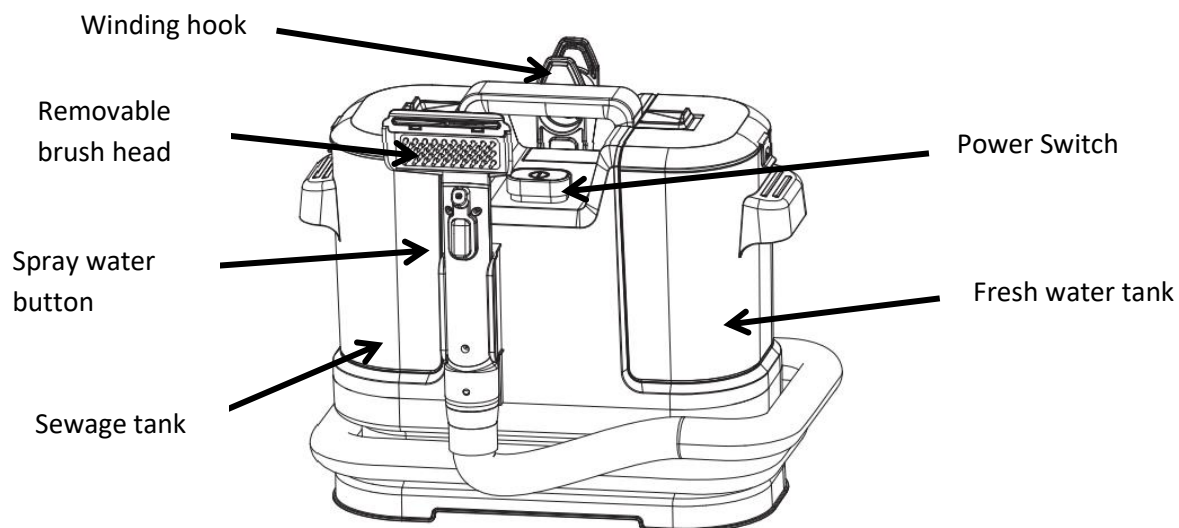
⑨ Do not use cleaners other than those specified. (The specified cleaning agent is a household non-foaming cleaner.)

About the machine

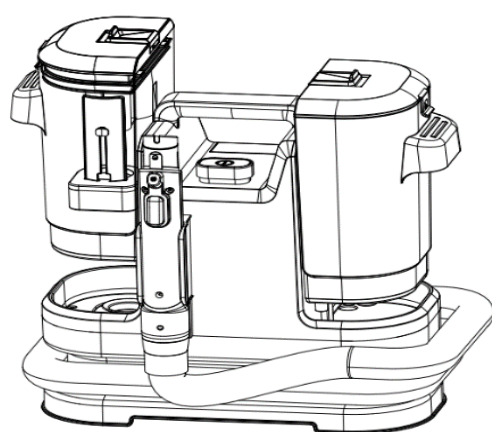
- ① When handling sewage and cleaning solutions, local environmental protection regulations should be followed.

- ③ Using a voltage that does not correspond to the specifications of this product will damage the motor and may even cause harm to the user. The correct rated voltage is marked on the nameplate.
- ④ Do not shake the machine up and down or hit it violently to prevent sewage from flowing into the motor.
- ⑤ When the motor is working, please do not lift or carry the appliance up and down, and do not tilt the machine to one side or lay it flat to prevent sewage from entering the motor.
- ⑥ To prevent tripping, the machine should be placed against a wall after use.
- ⑦ Do not use if the clean water tank and sewage bucket are not installed correctly.
- ⑧ Do not place any small objects on the air outlet, and do not block the air outlet. Remove any small objects that may hinder the smooth air flow of the air outlet to prevent the machine from overheating.
- ⑨ Do not get the machine body wet, otherwise fire and electric shock may occur due to short circuit of the machine.
- ⑩ The water tank contains water stains, which are residues from product testing before leaving the factory. This is a normal phenomenon, so please feel free to use it.

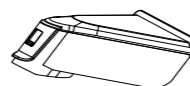

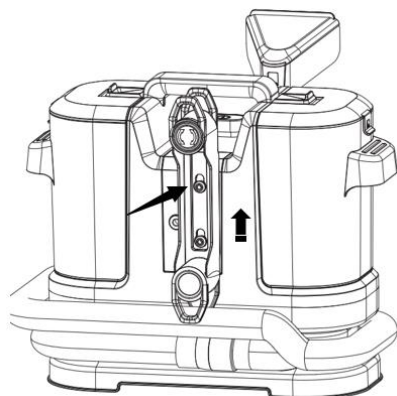

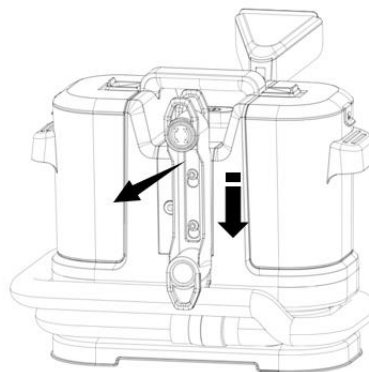

① Installation of wire winding hook

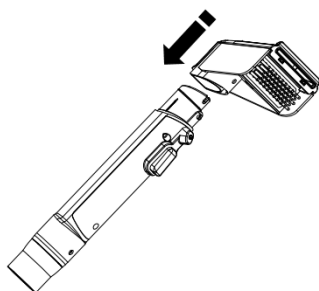


Insert the winding hook into the cylinder of the machine body and push it upward until you hear a "pop!" sound, then the installation is complete.

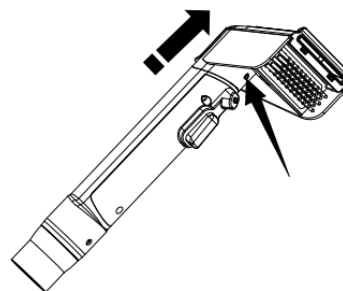


To disassemble, push the thread winding hook down, unhook and take it out.

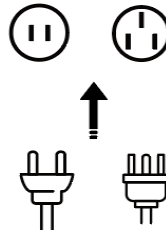

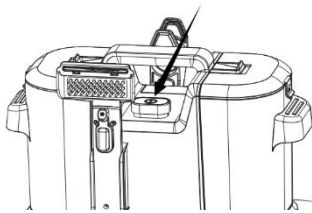
3.1 Daily using



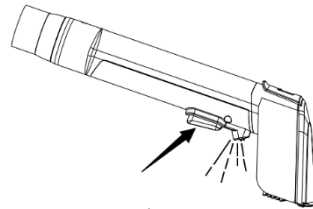
1. Check whether it can be washed according to the washing label on the fabric.



2. Insert the corresponding plug according to the socket type.



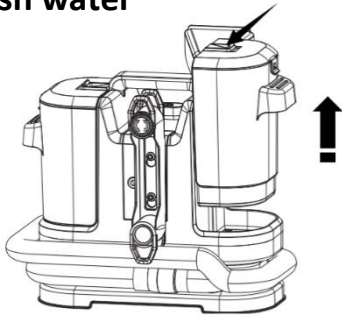
3. Press and hold the power button of the main unit, and the machine will sound.



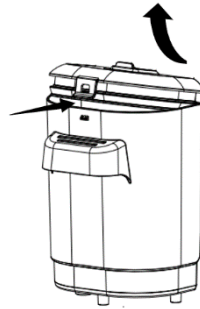
4. Press and hold the water spray button to start cleaning.

4. For Wet Stains. Turn ON using the power button and vacuum up the liquid mess. Spray the stain area. Scrub with the bristles, then tilt hand tool forward and drag across the stain area to extract liquid. Repeat if needed.
5. For Dry stains. Turn ON using the power button. spray the stain area. Scrub stain again, then tilt hand tool forwards and drag across the stain area to extract liquid. Repeat if needed.

Add fresh water



1. Slide the water tank slide button and pull out the clean water tank vertically.



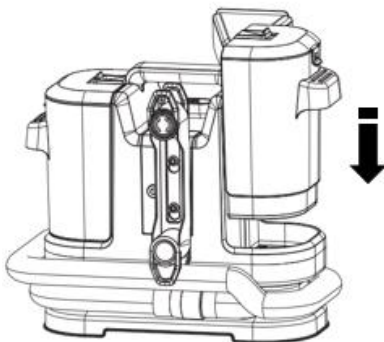
2. Unlock the lock and open the fresh water tank cover.



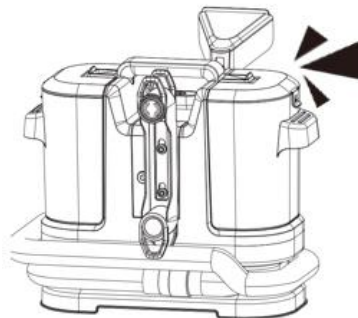
3. Pour in appropriate amount of water.



4. Close the clean water tank cover.

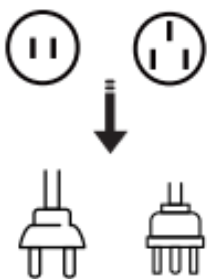


5. Reinstall the clean water tank vertically.

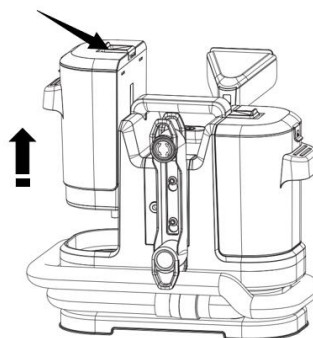


6. When you hear a "click", the installation is complete.

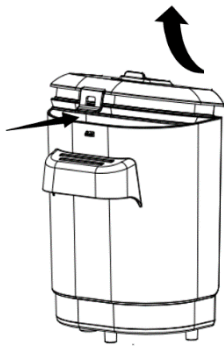
5.1 Routine maintenance



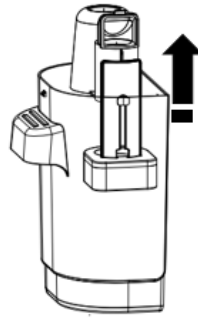
1. Before maintenance, confirm whether the product is powered off



2. Slide the outer water tank lock hook and remove the sewage tank vertically.



3. Open the sewage tank cover



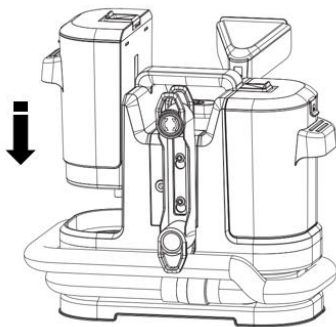
4. Remove the buoy bracket



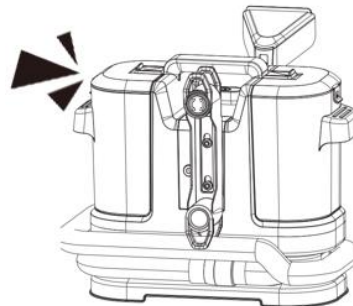
5. Rinse the sewage tank, dry it in the shade and then reinstall it.



6. Clean the buoy bracket, dry it in the shade and then reinstall it.



7. Install the sewage tank vertically



8. When you hear a "click", the installation is complete.

Kind tips:

The machine should be stored in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

5.2 Troubleshooting

If you find some abnormalities during use of the machine, you can check and eliminate them by referring to the table below.

Problems:	Check item
Product does not start:	Check if there is power
Product has no suction:	Whether the sewage reaches the MAX line and the buoy rises.
The water spray nozzle does not spray water:	<p>1. The water pipe is long, please wait patiently. Water will usually come out within 3 seconds.</p> <p>2. Check whether there is water in the clean water tank.</p>

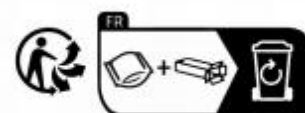
DO NOT use with any other mains transformer/charger than the one that is supplied with this product.
