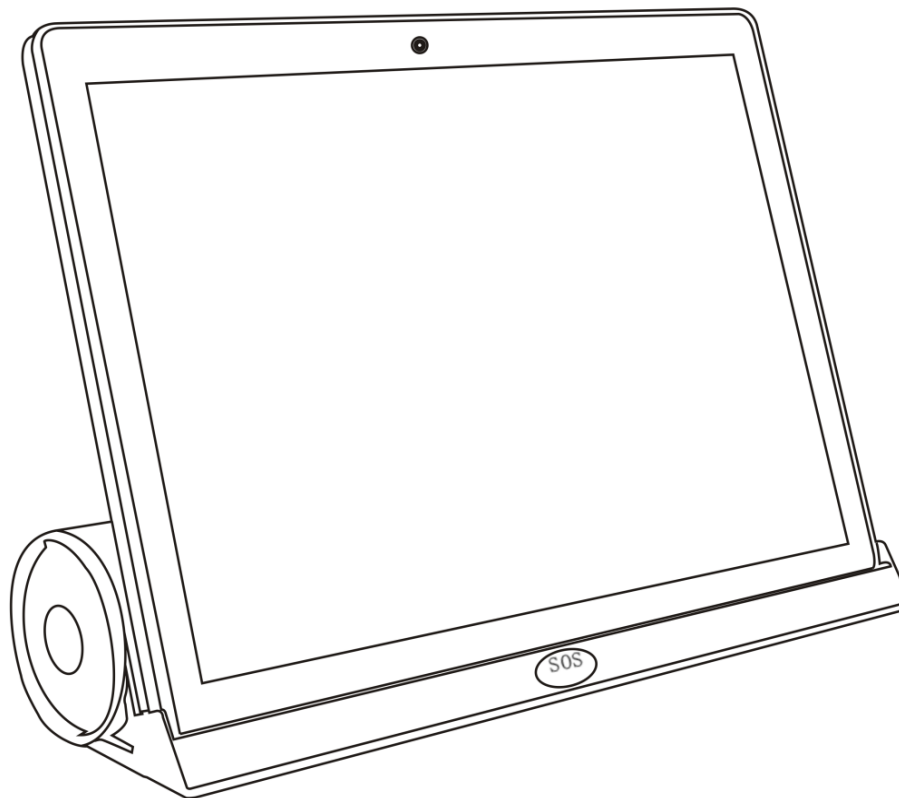

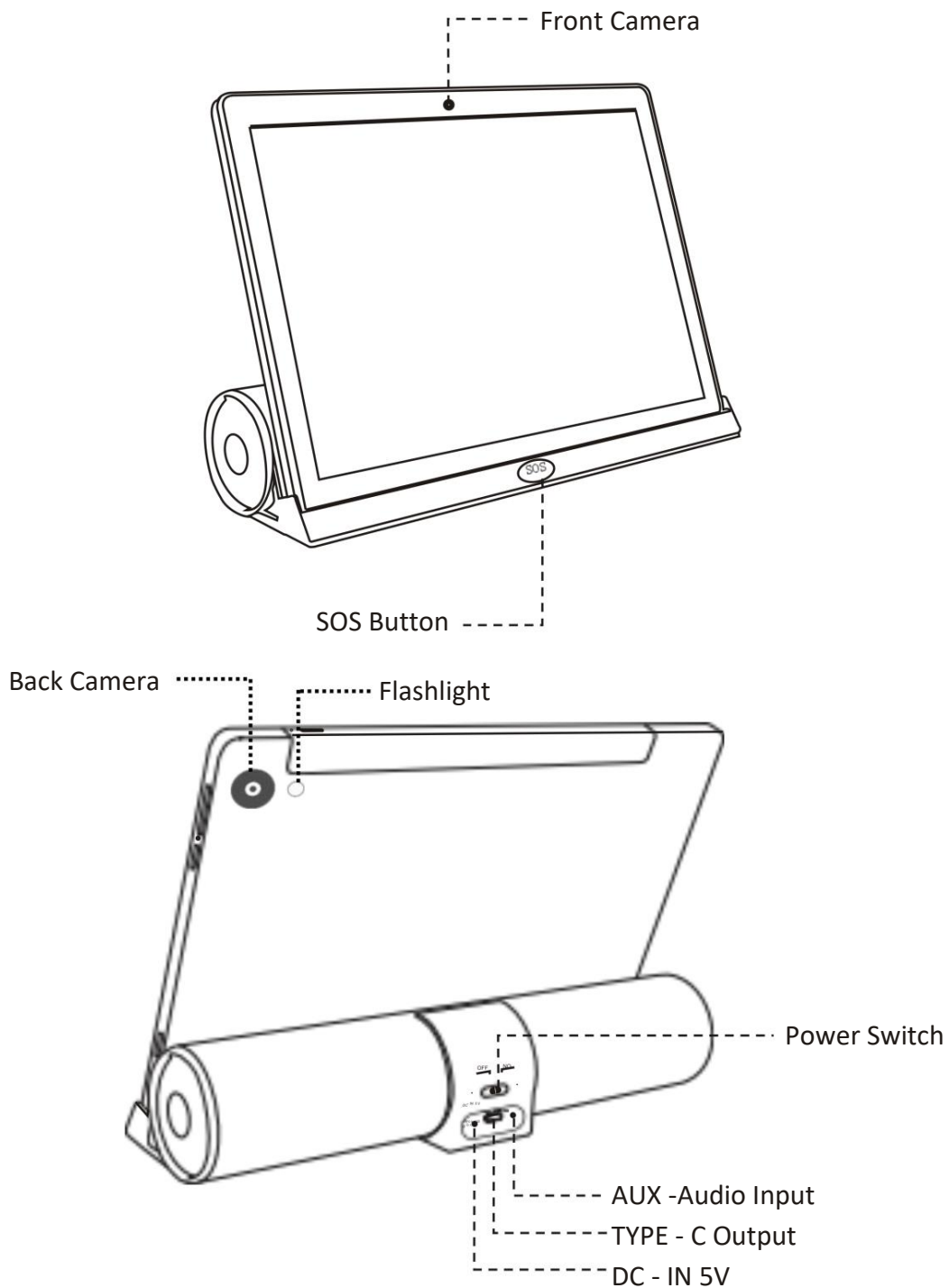

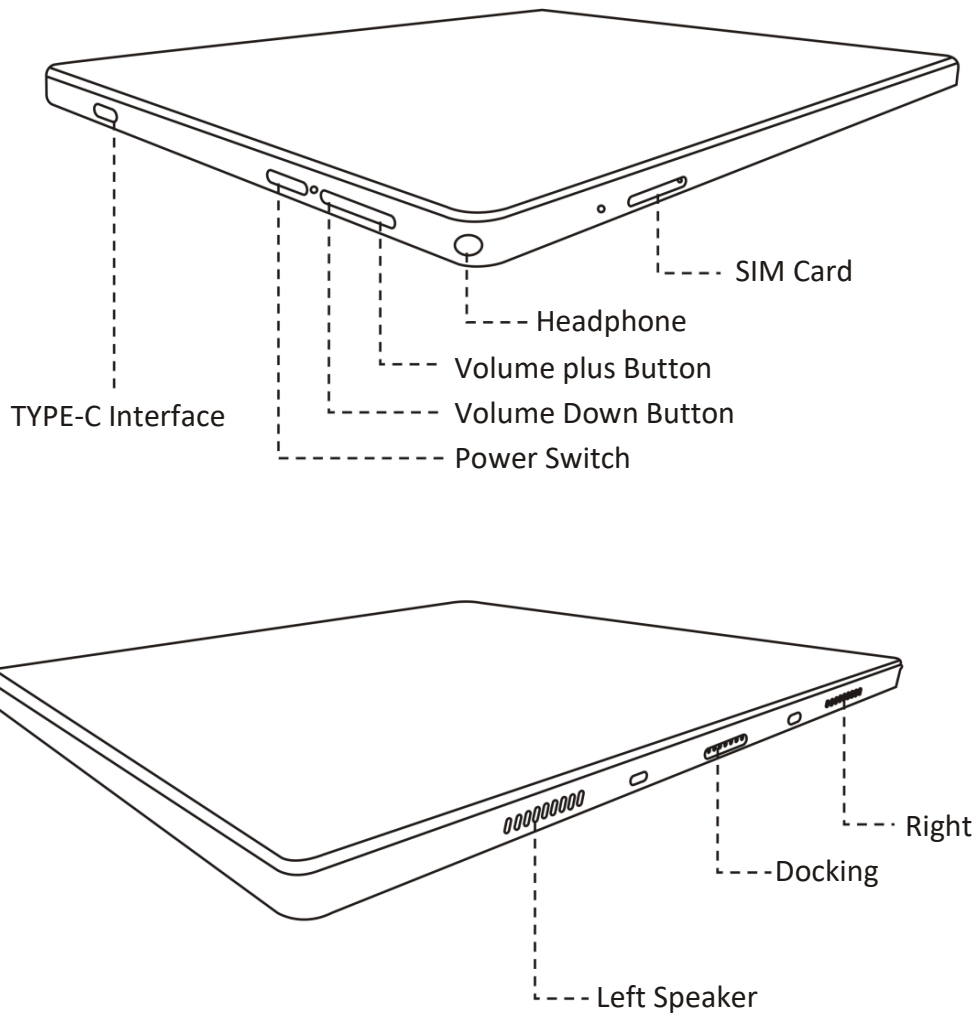

### ⌘ Start up

In the off state, long press the power button, the system enters the startup screen.

### ⌘ Shut down

In the power- on state, long press the power button to start shutting down.

### ⌘ Main interface introduction

a. Status bar: Enter the specific function menu, the top column of the interface is the status bar, displaying information: time, battery power, Bluetooth, WIFI ;

b. Function icon: In the main interface, click the icon directly to enter various functions or Perform relevant settings on the machine.

### ⌘ **Connect to WLAN Network**

- a. Swipe down on the status bar to open the notification panel or find "WLAN" in "Settings";
- b. Turn on the WLAN switch, and the system will list the detected WLAN Network signals in a list;
- b. Tap the WLAN network you want to connect. If an encrypted network is selected, enter the password to connect.

### ⌘ **Connect to Bluetooth**

- a. Swipe down on the status bar to open the notification panel or find " Bluetooth" in " Settings";
- b. Turn on the " Bluetooth" switch, enter the Bluetooth setting interface, and search for the Bluetooth address;
- c. Click the name of the Bluetooth address to be to perform pairing and connection.

### ⌘ **Use Expansion Card**

The machine has a expansion TF card slot, which can put videos, pictures, etc. into the memory card. When using, you need to insert the expansion card correctly according to the setting of the card slot, and push the card until you hear a click. When taking out the memory card, please push the memory card into the slot, then release it, the memory card will pop out automatically, and then take out the memory card.

( Please do not insert it backwards, it may cause damage to the memory card or the machine. Damage caused by reversed insertion is not covered by the warranty.)

### ⌘ **Charging operation and battery management**

- a. It can be charged by connecting the USB charging port of the machine to a computer, mobile power supply or other charging equipment through a USB cable.
- b. The battery needs to go through several charging and discharging processes to achieve the best performance;

c. If the machine is not used for a long time, please charge and discharge it at least once.

## ☞ Startup Wizard

When you first start up your device, the startup wizard will help you set the device display language is the first thing you need to set.

You can also change all the settings shown in the Startup Wizard later if you are not sure what to do.

## ☞ Accessing the Home screen

- Tap the home screen icon 

Lock the screen

The screen turns off and locks when the tablet is not in use.

Caution! The tablet continues to operate while it is asleep. Receive emails, social network updates, etc.


Activating the screen

- Short press the power button.


Locking the screen

- Press the power button briefly.

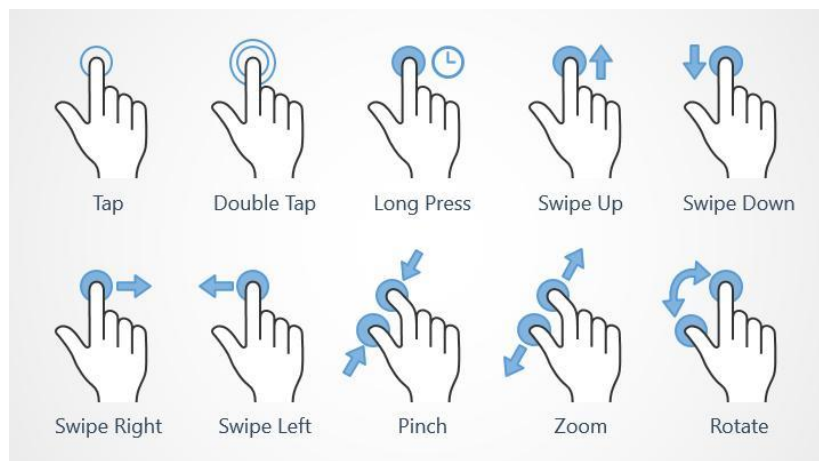
## ☞ Return key

Tap  to return to the previous screen, or to close a dialog box or menu.

## ☞ Background Apps

Tap  to see the background apps on your tablet, and tap any background app to enter or cancel any background app.

## Touch screen actions and gestures



### Tap

- Tap an item, such as a button or a program icon, to select it or to open it. Tap can be used to select or deselect a relevant tick box in a list of options.

**Double tap**

- Touch the same item twice to zoom in on a map or an image.

**Long press**

- Touch and hold an item on the screen. Some actions, such as to move an icon on the Home screen, begins with a long press.

**Swipe**

- A swipe is when you press your finger to the screen and drag it, the screen moves. Swiping to the left on the Home screen, for example, moves you to the next Home screen. Drag or flick your finger on the screen in the direction you want to go. Think of it as using the left- or right-arrow keys on a computer keyboard. Flick means to swipe more quickly on a page, quickly flick your finger on the screen in the direction you want to move.

**Pinch**

- Place two fingers separated on the screen and pinch them together to zoom out of a map. This function is not always applicable.

**Zoom**

- Place two fingers together on the screen and spread them to zoom in. This function is not always applicable.

**Rotate view in maps**

- Using two fingers, rotate the map clockwise or counterclockwise. Touch the Compass Pointer icon to reorient the map with north at the top of the screen.

**Drag and drop**


- Dragging and dropping is a way of moving something – for example, an app on your desktop – from one place to another. To drag, put your finger on an app and hold down. As you move your finger across your screen, the app is dragged across the screen, or across several screens. Place your finger where you want the app to go and release your finger. The app drops.

**⌂ Aeroplane mode**

In Aeroplane mode you can't make or receive calls, surf the web or download emails, or do anything that requires an Internet connection, this is to prevent disturbance to sensitive equipment. You can still play games, listen to music, watch videos and other content, as long as all this content is saved on your memory card or internal storage.

When you take your tablet abroad, you can keep it in flight mode. If you do that, there's no chance of data roaming charges, and you can still enable Wi-Fi. Enable Aeroplane mode when in areas with no network coverage to save battery since the tablet repeatedly scans for available networks and this consumes power. You can be notified by alarms, if alarms are activated.

1. From the home screen, scroll down to the status bar and find Aeroplane mode.
2. Tap the right on button to turn the feature on.

Tip:  It will be shown in the status bar when it is enabled.

## ⌘ Reset the tablet

### IMPORTANT!

Resetting the tablet means that most information, such as downloaded and installed applications, accounts, system and application data and settings, will be erased. Be sure to backup any data and files you want to keep before you perform the reset. A backup is a safety copy of information. Carefully read all the text below before you start.

Erase all data (factory reset) to erase all data from your tablet's internal storage, including:

- Your Google account.
- System and app data and settings.
- Downloaded apps.
- Music/videos/photos.
- Other user data.

The reason for performing a factory reset (clearing all data (factory reset)) may be a stubborn problem that cannot be solved, or you want to transfer the tablet to someone else.

### CAUTION!

This is the last step before ALL data from the device, including Google or other account settings, system and application data and settings will be permanently erased.


After your tablet resets, it will be set back to factory defaults and will be just like it was when it came out of the box.


## ⌘ Google™ Play Store

Note! You need to have a Google™ account to use Play Store. Your G-mail account is also your Google Account, so you can use the same G-mail username and password to use other Google products like YouTube, Google Play, and Google Drive.

Browse the available applications and games through different categories or through the lists like Top paid and Top Free. You can also search for a specific application or game. Some applications need to be purchased. The cost is shown in the application description, the same goes if the application is free. You pay using Google™ Pay, which can be registered when setting up a Google™ account or the first time for a purchase.

## ⌘ Install applications

1. From the Home screen, tap  Play Store.
2. Find an item you wish to download by browsing categories or by using the search function.
3. Tap the item to view its details, and follow the instructions to complete the installation/purchase.

Tip: All downloaded applications can be found in  Play Store. Tap the account icon with first letter of your account in the top right of the display, and tap to select manage apps and devices.

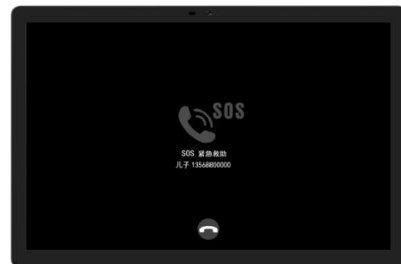

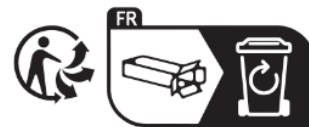
