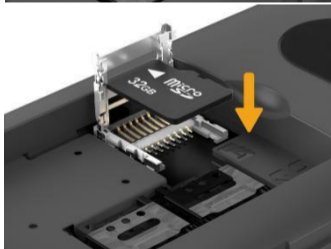
Insert a memory card: In order to use media player functions, a micro-SD memory card is required (not included in the package). Insert the micro-SD card as below

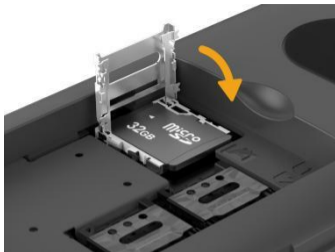

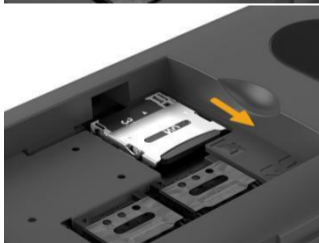

Connect to a PC: Use a Type-C cable to connect the product to a computer. Select Mass Storage on your phone, you can save songs to "My Music" in the SD card.

It's normal for the battery to get slightly warm during the charging process. The battery will reach its full capacity only after several complete charging cycles.

You can set up 8 contacts on speed dial, you will assign each contact to a number from 2 to 9, to call the contact, hold the number assigned to them and it will call the contact

To write a message to a new contact we suggest setting them up as a new contact & follow the process above

View messages:

Make a call:

Call log:

To make a call from your dialed call log, press the green button on the home screen and it will bring up your call activity. Select the caller and press the green dial button to call them.

Main menu > Call Log App > OK > Choose from 1. Missed calls, 2. Dialed calls, 3. Received Calls, 4. Rejected Calls, 5. Delete all

To call someone back from your missed /dialed /received /rejected call list, select the number/contact and press the green dial button.

SOS:

Main menu > SOS > OK > Choose from 1. SOS status, 2. SOS Contact, 3. SOS Messages, 4. SOS Ring Status

1. **SOS Status** > OK > Choose from Activate or Off > OK – that will save the status
2. **SOS contact** > OK > 1-5 > Options, 1. Edit Number / 2. Add from contacts / 3. Delete / 4. Delete all

Edit Number – Input phone number > OK

Add from contacts – Select the contact > Press 5 to confirm

When the SOS button is pressed the phone will automatically call the emergency contacts, it will call them in order you input them. 1 being the first contact they call. If number 1 doesn't answer it will call, contact number 2 etc.

3. **SOS message** > OK > existing emergency message that will be sent to all 5 contacts if the SOS button is pressed. This can be edited > OK to save the updated message.

4. **SOS Ring Status** > OK > Choose from Activate or Off > OK – that will save the status - When activated the phone will outlet an alarm before calling emergency contacts when the SOS button is pressed.

Settings:

Settings > Ok > Call settings / Phone settings / Display / Security / Profiles / Connections

1. Call Settings > OK > Dual-Sim / Call Divert / Call waiting / Call barring / Hide ID / Others

Dual-SIM: You can set standby mode, reply by original SIM, set SIM name and set dual SIM call divert through this function.

Call divert: This function enables you to forward incoming calls to another number you have previously specified.

Call waiting: After you choose Activate, the mobile phone will contact the network. A moment later, the network will make a response and send a message to acknowledge your operation. If the call waiting function is activated, the network will alert you and the mobile phone screen will display the incoming call number if others are calling you while you are already in a conversation.

Call barring: The call barring function enables you to bar calls as needed. When setting this function, you need to use a network barring code, which can be obtained from the network operator. If the code is wrong, an error message will be prompted on the screen. After selecting a call barring option, continue to select Activate or Deactivate. The mobile phone will prompt you to input the call barring code and then contact the network. A moment later, the network will make a response and send the operation results to the mobile phone.

Hide ID: You can select hide ID, display own ID and or display ID by network.

Others: You can set call time minute reminder, auto redial , reply SMS after reject and auto record voice call through this function.

2. Phone settings

Date & time: Set the time, set the date, Set the date format, the time format and update time settings.

Note: If you remove the battery from the mobile phone or if the battery energy was exhausted a long time ago, you may need to reset the date and time when re-inserting the battery or powering on the mobile phone after recharging.

Language settings: Select the display language for the mobile phone.

Shortcut settings: Select preferred function as shortcut on screen direction key as needed.

Auto power on/off : Set the time when the mobile phone will be automatically powered on or off.

Restore factory settings: You can reset your phone,the original code is 1234.

Note: All the data will be clear if you choose Restore factory setting .

3.Display

Users can access this item to set Wallpaper, Main display setting, contrast, backlight and keypad blacklist time etc.

4.Security

This function provides you with related settings about safety use

PIN: To activate PIN lock, you need to input the correct PIN code. If you set PIN lock to On, you need to input the PIN each time you power on the mobile phone. In the case you input a wrong PIN for three consecutive times; you need to input the PIN Unlocking Key (PUK). The PUK is used to unlock and change the locked PIN. To obtain the PUK, contact the network operator.

Modify PIN2: To change PIN2 code of PIN code.

Phone locked: The function enables you to lock/unlock the phone. Entering password to switch on or off the phone. Password is required when the phone is locked. The initial password is 1234.

Modify the cellphone password: to change phone password.

Privacy: You can set password to protect your privacy, the initial password is 1234.

Lock screen by end-key: You can select to turn on/off this function.

Fixed dialing number: the phone supports fixed dialing number, which allows calls only to predefined numbers.

Blacklist: The number which you add to blacklist cannot call you.

5.Profiles

The mobile phone provides multiple user profiles, so that you can customize some settings to adapt to the specific events and environments.

Customize the user profiles according to your preference and then activate the user profiles. The user profiles fall into three scenarios: **Normal, Silent, Indoor,Outdoor**. In the standby mode long press # can switch scenarios.

6.Connections

Contact the network operator to obtain the following network services:

Network account: You can manage network account through this function.

Date Service: You can select to turn on/off this function.

Data connection settings: The default setting is connecting when needed.

Network selection: Set Network selection mode to Automatic or Manual. Automatic is recommended. When Network selection mode is set to Automatic, the mobile phone will prefer the network where the SIM card is registered. When Network selection mode is set to Manual, you need to select the network operator's network where the SIM card is registered.

Network type: You can select network type ,there are three options:

4G/3G/2G Multi Mode

The exposure standard for mobile devices employs a unit of

measurement known as the Specific Absorption Rate, or SAR. Tests for SAR are conducted using standard operating positions with the device transmitting at its highest certified well below the maximum value. Although the SAR is determined at the highest certified power level, the actual SAR of the device while operating can be well below the maximum value. This is because the device is designed to operate at multiple power levels so as to use only the power required to reach the network. In general, the closer you are to a base station, the lower the power output of the device.

SAR values may vary depending on national reporting and testing requirements and the network band. Use of device accessories and enhancements may result in different SAR values.

The SAR limit for mobile devices used by the public is 2.0 W/kg averaged over 10 grams of body tissue. The guidelines incorporate a substantial margin of safety to give additional protection for the public and to account for any variations in measurements.
