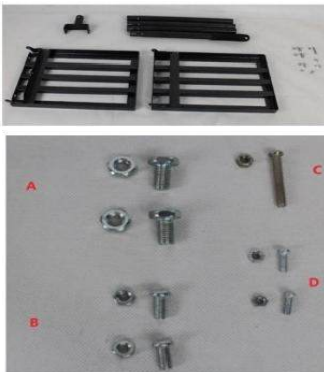


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTION FOR USE:

Check contents

Before beginning assembly, please ensure all parts and fittings are included:

- 2 pcs main frame sections
- 1 pc central support bracket
- 4 pcs poles
- 7 sets of Screws & Nuts (Various types A,B,C,D)



⚠ Important Notes

Assemble on a flat, clean surface to avoid scratching or damaging parts.

Do not fully tighten any screws until all parts are in place.

Use the correct screws (A, B, C, D) as indicated for each step.

Recommended tools: wrench or spanner, screwdriver.

ASSEMBLY STEPS

Step 1 – Connect the Frames (Part D)

Use 2 sets of D screws and nuts to connect the two frame sections together securely.

Step 2 – Reinforce the Frame (Part B)

Attach the frame sections using 2 sets of B screws and nuts to strengthen the connection.

Step 3 – Attach the Bracket (Part A)

Connect the bracket to the assembled frame using 2 sets of A screws and nuts.

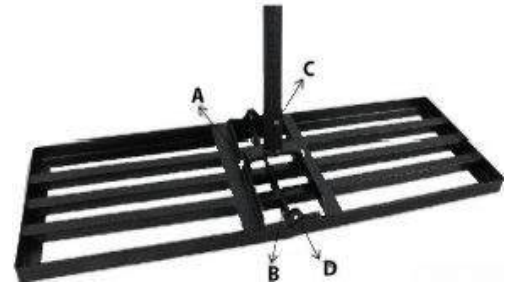
Step 4 – Fit the Poles

Install and rotate the poles into place until they are firmly secured.

Step 5 – Secure the Poles (Part C)

Use C screw and nuts to attach each pole to the frame.

Tighten all screws once the structure is fully aligned.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Check the equipment is assembled correctly
- Prepare your lawn – mow the grass short, remove any debris
- Lightly water the lawn or soil before levelling, avoid over watering

Step 1 – Evenly spread your chosen material (topsoil, compost or sand mix) across uneven areas of your lawn using a shovel or spreader

Step 2 – Hold the leveller handle firmly with both hands. Push and pull the leveller in a back-and-forth motion across the surface. Work in multiple directions (lengthways and crossways) to achieve a uniform finish.

Step 3 – For deeper dips, add more material and repeat the levelling process until the surface feels even underfoot.

Step 4 – Water gently to help the soil or sand settle.

AFTER USE

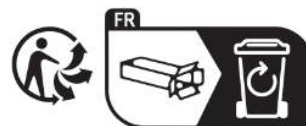
- Rinse the leveller thoroughly with water to remove soil or debris.
- Dry completely before storage to prevent rust or corrosion.
- Store indoors or under cover, away from moisture and direct sunlight.


CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Do NOT use abrasive cleaners or sharp utensils to clean this product.
- Store the item in a cool, dry place.
- Wipe with a clean dry cloth.

DISPOSAL

- Coopers of Stortford use recyclable or recycled packaging where possible.
- Please dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons in accordance with your local authority recycling regulations.
- At the end of the product's lifespan please check with your local council authorised household waste recycling centre for disposal.
