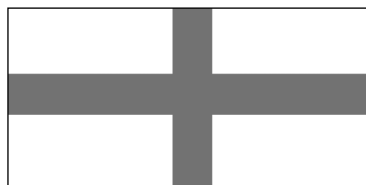


Flag Pole Set⁶⁰⁴⁸

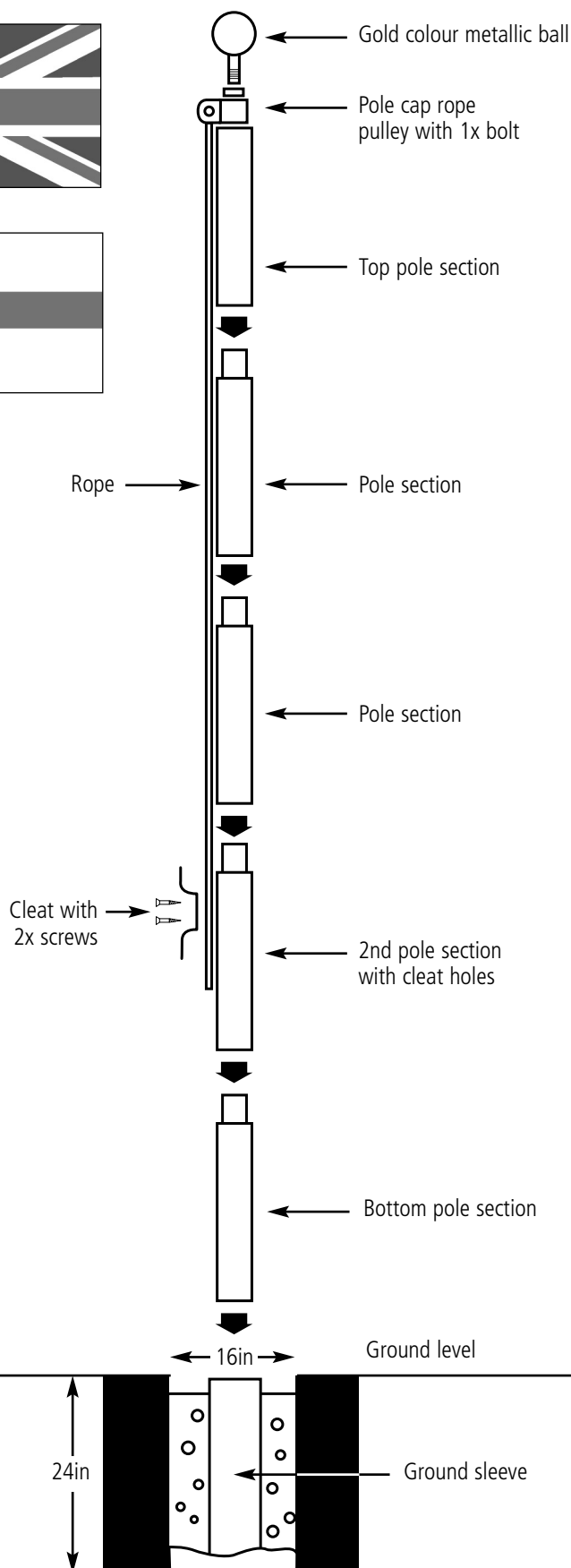
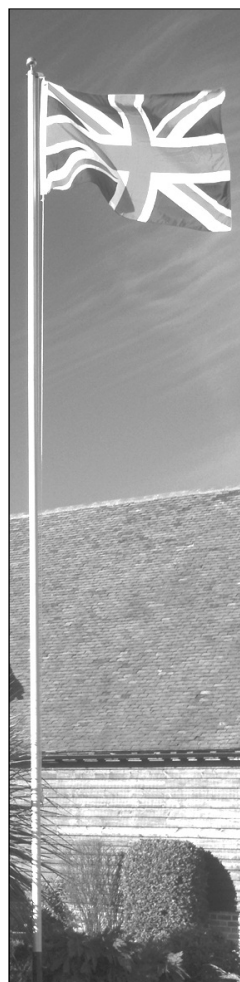
Instructions



Union Flag



St. George Flag



PARTS:

- 36in x72in (91cm x183cm) Union Flag and St. George Flag
- Gold colour metallic ball
- Pole cap with rope pulley with 1x bolt
- Length of rope
- Cleat with 2x screws
- 5 aluminium flag pole sections
- Ground sleeve
- 2x white clips

ASSEMBLY

1. Sink the Ground sleeve into a 16in x24in hole then back fill with a suitable concrete post mix.
2. Screw the gold coloured metallic ball into the pole cap and secure using the nut. Attach the pole cap to the untapered pole section using the bolt.
3. Once the post mix has set, place one of the tapered pole sections (without the screw holes) inside the ground sleeve.
4. Fix the cleat to the tapered pole section with screw holes and secure using the 2x screws. Attach this section to the assembled base section.
5. Attach the remaining tapered pole sections to the assembled section.
6. Fit the rope into the groove on the pulley wheel, located in the pole cap.
7. Attach the 2x white clips to the ends of the rope and to the flag eyelets.
8. Pull the rope down to hoist the flag.
9. Tie off the rope tail to the cleat.

WARNING

Please check with your local Council before erecting this flag pole as planning permission may be required. There may also be rules concerning when flags are permitted to be flown.

GUIDELINE FOR FLAG FLYING

To prolong the life of your flag, it is recommended that flags are taken in every night.

Do not fly flags in inclement weather.

Ensure that flags are flown in accordance with flag etiquette at all times.

DISPOSAL

Dispose of all paper, cartons and plastic in accordance with your local recycling regulations. At the end of the product's lifespan please dispose of it at an authorised household waste recycling centre.
