

1. Clean the window thoroughly before fitting the foil.
2. Measure the window and cut the foil to size allowing an extra 2cm all round.
3. Sprinkle some water or glass cleaning agent onto the window pane and onto both sides of the foil.
4. Press the foil firmly onto the window starting at the top.
5. Use the window squeegee to smooth down air bubbles or water between the foil and the glass by starting at the centre and working towards the outside.
6. Use a sharp craft knife with a ruler to cut off the surplus foil, taking care not to damage the window frame.
7. Any remaining condensation will evaporate in a few days. Take care not to touch the foil in the first 24 hours of fitting. If any air bubbles develop, peel off and reapply.
8. The foil is removable and reusable. Keep the packing instructions and protective paper for reuse.
9. The foil can be fitted to the inside or outside of windows. NB: (1) If your glass is of a specialised type, such as thermal, we suggest you take advice from your glazing supplier before use. (2) If the foil is to be fitted to double glazing over 0.5 square metres per individual pane, only attach the foil to the outside of the glass to avoid glass breakage caused by tension. (3) It is recommended that the foil is fitted on the outside of conservatories.
