TO BE USED IN A SHOWER TRAY

INSTALLATION:

- Rinse mat thoroughly before first use.
- Wet the shower tray surface with a small amount of water.
- Place the Shower Tray Foot Loofah mat into the shower tray. The loofah mat can be placed over the plug hole as water will flow through the mat.
- Press down on each suction cup firmly and ensure these are secure in each use.
- Ensure the Loofah mat is secure in the shower tray.

WARNING:

- Ensure the suction cups are secured to a smooth and even surface before each use.
- Do not use on an uneven or textured surface to avoid risk of slipping.
- When stepping onto the mat, tread carefully onto the centre of the mat.
- Take care when stepping off the loofah mat. Hold onto a hand rail or grab bar for added balance and to avoid slipping.
- Bath oils, foam bath and soap may affect the efficiency of the suction cups.
- Clean well after every use.
- Do not use with metal or steel surfaces.

CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

- After use, remove wash and rinse off soap residue and hang to dry.
- Always lift and clean both top and bottom of the mat regularly, at least once a week.
- Machine washable at 30 degrees C.
- Do not dry clean.











If you require a mat for use in baths then please select a mat that complies with BS8445 or CPSD-GB0014 skid resistance such as:- J10040 blue, J10040 white, J10040 clear and 8023 white, 8023 clear.

DISPOSAL

- Dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons and plastic and plastic bags in accordance with your local recycling regulations.
- At the end of the product's lifespan please dispose of it at an authorised household waste recycling centre.
