

PARTS

Guard sections x20

Rings x40

BEFORE USE

- Check all pieces are present and not damaged before assembly.
- Assess the size of your pond. If necessary, use a length of string to measure the pond circumference. Note: Land-based predators only strike at the edge of ponds so it is not necessary to cover the whole pond.

ASSEMBLY

- Attach the Guard sections together in pairs (Fig A) using the rings.
- Join the pairs together to cover the required area of the pond using the rings (Fig B) before placing over pond.
- If necessary, the net sections can be cut using secateurs or strong scissors to allow for any pond plants or other obstacles to rise through the Fish Guard.

WARNING

- Do not stand on the Fish Guard.
- For domestic use only.

CLEANING

- Wipe or hose clean.

DISPOSAL

Dispose of all paper, cartons and plastic in accordance with your local recycling regulations. At the end of the product's lifespan please dispose of it at an authorised household waste recycling centre.

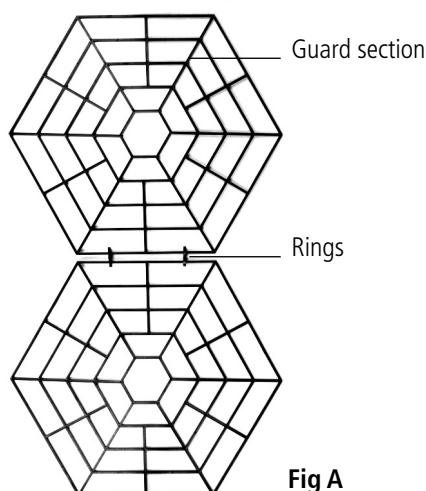

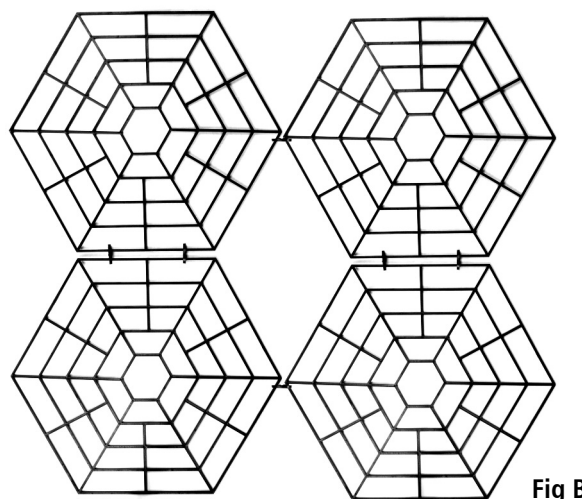
