In order to get the maximum performance and life from your new torch, please read the following instructions carefully before use.

- Store your torch and charger in a dry place, away from moisture and heat. Only use the charger in a dry location, away from any source of moisture or heat.
- Recharge the torch as soon as you notice the light begin to fail or dim. Do not allow your torch to completely discharge.
- Never mix new & old batteries or different battery types together.
- Stop charging the torch when the LED indicator turns green.
- Do not charge the torch for longer than 24 hours.
- Take care when using the car charger, prolonged use with the engine off may drain your car battery sufficiently to prevent you starting the car.
- If it becomes necessary to replace the batteries, only replace with exactly the same type/specification of battery as originally supplied.
- Do not use the torch whilst it is being charged.
- Charge the torch at least once every 3 months if not being used and re-charged regularly.
- If not in use for extended time, charge torch fully then remove battery, store as above.

## **WARNING**

- The 10W CREE torches is one of the most powerful torches available, do not shine the torch at someone's face, oncoming vehicles, etc.
- Install the battery according to the correct polarity, with the positive end towards the torch head.
- The battery is pre-charged and does not normally need to be charged before first use. However, recharge the torch as soon as you notice the light begin to fail or dim.

## **CLEANING**

- Wipe clean with a soft damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or scourers.

## **BATTERIES**

- Contains 2x 3.7v DC Lithium batteries.
- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Install batteries in accordance with its polarity symbols.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Battery disposal, spent or expired batteries must be properly disposed of and recycled in compliance with local regulations. For detailed information, contact your local authority.
- Follow the battery manufacturer's safety, usage, and disposal instructions.

## **DISPOSAL**
