

Operation:

Slide power switch (D) to desired setting: R for roaches, high frequency 38-65KHz, red light.


Y for mosquitoes, medium frequency 30-38KHz, yellow light.


G for mice, low frequency 23-30KHz, green light.

Note: sound cycle 5 seconds ON and 20 seconds OFF.

LED (E) lights during the ON cycle so you know it is working.

Place unit where desired, laying on its base or hang using fixings provided.


