ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Unpack the components carefully. Please check all parts have been removed from the packaging.

Take out folded product from the box.

Insert and slide 3 legs upward into the slots of the base until firmly secured. Place on a level surface.

Connect the 5 poles. Insert the poles into the base.

Then pull up the folded tree from the top and position it on the supporting pole.



Install Batteries

- Remove battery compartment lid.
- Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
- Install 3x AA batteries (not included) as shown on the battery diagram in the battery compartment.
- Return battery compartment lid to original position.
- Switch on

BATTERIES
