- A. Top board x 1
- B. Back board x 1
- C. Small side board x 2 ( C-1 , C-2)
- D. Bottom board x 1
- E. Side board of magazine rack x 2 (E-1, E-2)
- F. Horizontal bar x 3

- 1. Bolts x 3
- 2. Nuts x 3
- 3. Screws x 12
- 4. Pads x 4
- 5. Plastic caps x 8

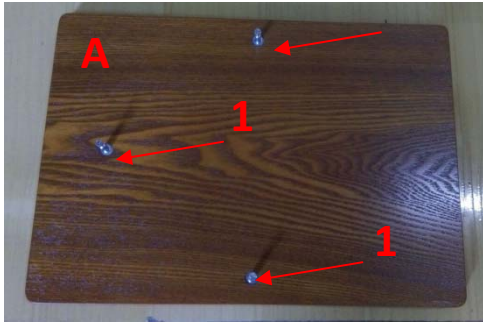
# Instructions for Use

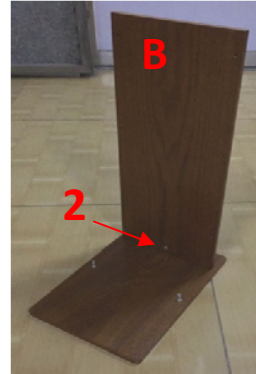

Assemble:

1. Set the Top board (A) upside down on a clean, soft surface. Secure 3 bolts (1) into the holes in the Top (A).



2. Insert the back board (B) and tighten the bolt by nut (2) inside of it.



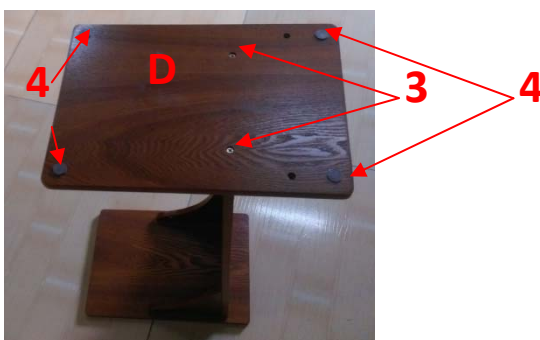
3. Assemble two small side boards (C) and tighten bolts by nut (2).



4. Use 4 screws (3) to secure back board (B) to two side board (C).



5. Use 2 screws (3) to tighten the Bottom board (D) to Side board (B) and add 4 Pads (4) on 4 corners.



6. Tighten the side board of magazine rack (E-1) by screws (3) from the side and bottom.

7. Insert 3 horizontal bar (F) to one end of side board (E-1).



8. Put another side board of magazine rack (E-2) and using screws (3) to tighten it from side and bottom.



\*\* The placement of screws (3) on 2 side boards of magazine rack.



\*\* Cover the plastic caps (5) on all screws holes.



## WARNINGS / CAUTIONS:

Adult Assembly Required

Do not place directly in front of or near sources of heat

Periodically check that all fixings are secure and tighten if necessary.
