



# Instructions for Use

• Set ON/OFF switch to ON for general use.

#### POSITIONING


Solar lights require charge throughout the day from the sun's rays. Ideally, they require a sunny position, although will gain some charge on an overcast day. Solar lights come on automatically at dusk.

#### BATTERIES

- Keep batteries away from children and pets.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Remove the batteries if left for long periods.
- Never dispose of batteries in a fire.
- Battery disposal, spent or expired batteries must be properly disposed of and recycled in compliance with local regulations. For detailed information, contact your local authority.
- Follow the battery manufacturer's safety, usage, and disposal instructions.

### DISPOSAL

- Dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons, plastic and plastic bags in accordance with your local recycling regulations.
- At the end of the product's lifespan please dispose of it at an authorised household WEEE waste recycling centre.



- Battery: 1xAAA 1.2V Ni-MH (each)
- To replace the battery, remove the four screws in each corner of the cover.
- Once the cover has been removed the battery can be replaced.
- Replace cover and then screw back into place.
