



Before using:

- Make sure both the window and 3 suction cups are clean by rinsing with warm water prior to mounting.
- A small drop of olive oil on the bottom of each suction cup will create a strong vacuum between the window and feeder, improving suction in very cold or very hot temperatures.

Tips

- To help birds discover your feeder, spread some bird seed on the ground nearby.
- Place your feeder about 12 to 15 feet from natural cover like trees and bushes, within easy reach of birds, but out of reach from cats and squirrels. Fill with bird feed.
- Birds prefer to feed where it is quiet and safe from predators. Up to 4 or 5 weeks may pass before birds discover and trust the feeder. Be patient and they will come.

Cleaning

- Clean and wash feeder regularly (a 5% disinfectant solution is recommended). Clean feeder outside, using separate utensils and wearing gloves. Always wash your hands after cleaning the bird feeder.

DISPOSAL

- Dispose of all packaging, paper, cartons, plastic and plastic bags in accordance with your local recycling regulations.
- At the end of the product's lifespan please dispose of it at an authorised household waste recycling centre.
